AN ORDINANCE SPECIFYING CERTAIN DUTIES OF VOTING BOARD CHAIRMEN, SETTING THE COMPENSATIONS FOR VOTING BOARD CHAIRMEN, VOTING BOARD OFFICERS, COUNTING BOARD OFFICERS AND SPECIALLY APPOINTED DEPUTY SHERIFFS DURING AN ELECTION; AND PROVING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.
