NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE

Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 437, Ordinance No. 274, amending Ordinance No. 182, entitled "An Ordinance establishing fees for solemnization of marriages by the office of the Commissioner of Civil Marriages, authorizing the hours of operation for the Office of the Commissioner of Civil Marriages to be established by the Commissioner, providing for payment of salaries to employees of the office of the Commissioner of Civil Marriages and Marriage License Bureau for Sundays and holidays at the same rate as other county employees, and other matters properly relating thereto".

SUMMARY: Amends Washoe County Ordinance No. 182 to provide that the Commissioner of Civil Marriages is entitled to receive as his fee for solemnizing a marriage during regular office hours on weekdays the sum of \$25 and on Saturdays, Sundays, holidays and during any hours other than regular business hours the sum of \$30.

ORDINANCE NO. 274

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEES FOR SOLEMNIZATION OF MARRIAGES BY THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF CIVIL MARRIAGES, AUTHORIZING THE HOURS OF OPERATION FOR THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF CIVIL MARRIAGES TO BE ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSIONER, PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF SALARIES TO EMPLOYEES OF THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF CIVIL MARRIAGES AND MARRIAGE LICENSE BUREAU FOR SUNDAYS AND HOLIDAYS AT THE SAME RATE AS OTHER COUNTY EMPLOYEES, AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.
Section 1 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 182 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1.
The Commissioner of Civil Marriages or his deputies shall charge and collect fees for the solemnization of marriages as follows:

- A. Twenty-Five and No/100 (\$25.00) Dollars for each solemnization of marriage performed during the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. to 5:00 o'clock p.m., Monday through Friday.
- B. Thirty and No/100 (\$30.00) Dollars for each solemnization of marriage performed during the hours of 5:00 o'clock p.m. to 12:00 midnight, Monday through Friday.
- C. Thirty and No/100 (\$30.00) Dollars for each solemnization of marriage performed during the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. to 12:00 midnight on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.

SECTION 2.
This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
