traffic supplementary to State Law; providing penalties for non-
compliance with the provisions hereof; providing other matters
property related thereto, and repealing ordinances and parts of

SUMMARY: Amends Washoe County Ordinance No. 143 to impose a 35 mile per hour speed limit on motor trucks in excess of 8,000 pounds unladen weight operating on a portion of Boynton Lane and a 45 mile per hour speed limit on all other vehicles operating on a portion of Boynton Lane.

ORDINANCE NO. 282

AN ORDINANCE TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH, PROPERTY AND SAFETY OF THE CITIZENS OF WASHOE COUNTY, STATE OF NEVADA, BY REGULATING TRAFFIC; PRESCRIBING MINIMUM STANDARD REQUIREMENTS IN REGARD TO TRAFFIC SUPPLEMENTARY TO STATE LAW; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

That section entitled "SOUTHEAST" found on page 22 of the appendix to Washoe County Ordinance No. 143, said appendix being entitled "RESTRICTED ZONES IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY" is hereby amended to read as follows:

OLD VIRGINIA CITY ROAD.....	35 MPH	KLEPPE LANE.....	35 MPH
SHORT LANE.....	35 MPH	LONGLEY LANE.....	30 MPH
BOYNTON LANE from its intersection with Rock Boulevard and Pembroke Drive to its intersec- tion with Peckham Lane Motor trucks in excess of 8,000 pounds un- laden weight.....	35 MPH	DeLUCCHI LANE.....	25 MPH
All other vehicles.....	45 MPH	MILL STREET.....	35 MPH

SECTION 2.

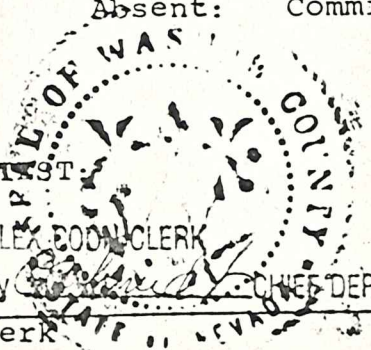
This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
