ORDINANCE NO. 297

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING STANDARDS FOR USE IN DETERMINING WHICH STREET INTERSECTIONS IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY REQUIRE INSTALLATION OF STREET LIGHTS; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.
Section 3, Paragraph D of Washoe County Ordinance No. 295 is hereby amended to read as follows:

D. An average daily traffic of at least two thousand (2,000) motor vehicles exists at such intersection, as determined from a survey made of any single week's traffic at such intersection.

SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
