AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE TO FIX, IMPOSE AND COLLECT A LICENSE TAX ON ALL CHARACTER OF LAWFUL TRADES, CALLINGS, INDUSTRIES, OCCUPATIONS, PROFESSIONS AND BUSINESS CONDUCTED IN THE COUNTY OF WASHOE, OUTSIDE OF THE LIMITS OF INCORPORATED CITIES AND TOWNS IN WASHOE COUNTY; FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING FOR SALE AT RETAIL OF SHELLS, CARTRIDGES OR BOMBS CONTAINING OR CAPABLE OF EMITTING TEAR GAS, OR ANY WEAPON DESIGNATED FOR THE USE OF SUCH SHELL, CARTRIDGE OR BOMB; AND REPEALING WASHOE COUNTY ORDINANCES NO. 31, 32, 46 AND 195.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 306 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. License Required for Engaging in Business. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, firm, association, or corporation to engage in any business, trade, calling, industry, occupation, or profession in the County of Washoe, outside of the limits of incorporated cities and towns in said county without first procuring a license therefor from the County of Washoe. The providing of care in private homes to less than seven children does not constitute engaging in a business, trade, calling, industry, occupation or profession.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
