Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 509, Ordinance No.
341, amending Ordinance No. 226, entitled "An Ordinance providing
for the licensing and inoculation against rabies of dogs in designated congested areas of the unincorporated area of Mashoe County;
provides for special permits to maintain in excess of three dogs;
prohibits dogs running at large or trespassing on private property;
provides for the quarantine of biting animals; provides for the
designation of a poundkeeper and the impoundment of animals found
in violation of the provisions of this ordinance; providing for
regulations for impoundment, destruction and release of animals;
prohibits the keeping of noisy animals; provides for the impounding
of all dogs endangering private or public property, public safety,
thenselves, or other animals; provides penalties for noncompliance
with the provisions hereof; and other matters properly relating
thereto by redefining the boundaries of Sun Valley as a designated
congested area and designating the Red Sock Road area as a conjected

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND INOCULATION AGAINST RABIES OF DOGS IN DESIG-NATED CONGESTED AREAS OF THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; PROVIDES FOR SPECIAL PERMITS TO MAINTAIN IN EXCESS OF THREE DOGS; PROHIBITS DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE OR TRES-PASSING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY; PROVIDES FOR THE QUARANTINE OF BITING ANIMALS; PROVIDES FOR THE DESIGNATION OF A POUND-KEEPER AND THE IMPOUNDMENT OF ANIMALS FOUND IN VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR REGULATIONS FOR IMPOUNDMENT, DESTRUCTION AND RELEASE OF ANIMALS; PRO-HIBITS THE KEEPING OF NOISY ANIMALS; PROVIDES FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF ALL DOGS ENDANGERING PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROP-ERTY, PUBLIC SAFETY, THEMSELVES, OR OTHER ANIMALS; PROVIDES PENALTIES FOR NONCOMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO" BY REDEFINING THE BOUNDARIES OF SUN VALLEY AS A DESIGNATED CONGESTED AREA AND DESIGNATING THE RED ROCK ROAD AREA AS A CONGESTED AREA IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSES OF SAID ORDINANCE.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.
Section 21 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 226 is hereby amended by repealing the property description for Sun Valley set forth in Paragraph J hereof and inserting a new property description for Sun Valley in said Paragraph J and by the addition to said Section 21 of Paragraph W, which said Paragraphs shall read as follows (all other paragraphs remaining the same):

Sun Valley J. All that certain area within the following described parcels of land within the unincorporated area of Washoe County: All of Sections 7, 17, 18, 19 and 20; the West one-half (W 1/2) and the Southeast one-quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 8; the Southwest one-quarter (SW 1/4) of Section 9; the North onehalf of the Northwest one-quarter (N 1/2 of the NW 1/4) of Section 16; the North one-half (N 1/2) of Section 29; the North one-half (N 1/2) and the North one-half of the South one-half (N 1/2 of the S 1/2) of Section 30, all in T.20N., R.20E. M.D.B. & M.; the Southeast one-quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 12; the East one-half $(\stackrel{.}{E} \ 1/2)$ of Section 13, and the East one-half (E 1/2) of Section 24, all in T.20N., R19E., M.D.B. & M.

Together with all that land contained in the unincorporated area of Washoe County lying in Sections 30, 31 and 32, T.20N., R.20E., M.D.B. & M. bounded by the partial corporate limits of the cities of Reno and Sparks.

Red Rock Road Area W. All that certain area within the following described parcels of land within the unincorporated area of Washoe County: All of Sections 24, 25 and 36; the East one-half (E 1/2) of Sections 23, 26 and 35, T.21N., R.18E., M.D.B. & M.; all of Section 1; the East one-half (E 1/2) of Section 2, and all of the land lying Northerly of the Western Pacific railroad track in the Northeast one-quarter (NE 1/4) of Section 11, and Section 12, T20N., R18E., M.D.B. & M.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
