Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 532, Ordinance No. 363, an ordinance amending Washoe County Ordinance No. 328 entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING 'AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A RABIES CONTROL AUTHORITY; PROVIDING FOR THE VACCINATION OF DOGS AGAINST RABIES; PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSITION OF BITING ANIMALS OR ANIMALS SUSPECTED OF HAVING RABIES; REGULATING ANIMAL BITE INVESTIGATION TO DETERMINE POSSIBLE RABIES EXPOSURE OF A HUMAN BEING; 'PROVIDING COORDINATION AND EDUCATION TO ALL ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES WHO ARE ASSISTING IN ENFORCEMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE; REGULATING OWNERSHIP OF CERTAIN HIGH RISK WILD ANIMALS; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO" BY EMPOWERING THE ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER TO ORDER THE PERIOD OF TIME FOR QUARANTINE OF A BITING ANIMAL AND TO AUTHORIZE HOME QUARANTINE FOR A BITING ANIMAL,; ELIMINATING THE CONDITION THAT AN OWNER OF AN ANIMAL AUTHORIZED TO BE QUARANTINED AT HOME MUST CONSENT IN WRITING TO A HOME QUARANTINED ANIMAL PRESENT TO THE ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER AS A HOME OF AN ANIMAL PRESENT TO THE ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER AS A HOME OF AN ANIMAL PRESENT TO THE ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER AS A HOME OF A BOUNDANY OF SAID ANIMAL, WAS adopted on December 27, 1977, by Commissioners Gaunt, Nelson, Farr and Stoess with Commissioner, Rusk being absent.

SUMMARY:

Amends Washoe County Ordinance No. 328 to empower the Animal Control Officer to order the period of time for quarantine of a biting animal and to authorize home quarantine for a biting animal; eliminates the condition that an owner of an animal authorized to be quarantined at home must consent in writing to a home quarantine; provides that an owner of a quarantined animal present to the Animal Control Officer a statement from a veterinarian regarding the examination and inoculation of said animal.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A RABIES CONTROL AUTHORITY; PROVIDING FOR THE VACCINATION OF DOGS AGAINST RABIES; PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSITION OF BITING ANIMALS OR ANIMALS SUSPECTED OF HAVING RABIES; REGULATING ANIMAL BITE INVESTIGATION TO DETERMINE POSSIBLE RABIES EXPOSURE OF A HUMAN BEING; PROVIDING COORDINATION AND EDUCATION TO ALL ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES WHO ARE ASSISTING IN ENFORCEMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE; REGULATING OWNERSHIP OF CERTAIN HIGH RISK WILD ANIMALS; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO" BY EMPOWERING THE ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER TO ORDER THE PERIOD OF TIME FOR QUARANTINE OF A BITING ANIMAL AND TO AUTHORIZE HOME QUARANTINE FOR A BITING ANIMAL; ELIMINATING THE CONDITION THAT AN OWER OF AN ANIMAL AUTHOR-IZED TO BE QUARANTINED AT HOME MUST CONSENT IN WRITING TO A HOME QUARANTINE; AND PROVIDING THAT AN OWNER OF A QUARAN-TINED ANIMAL PRESENT TO THE ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER A STATE-MENT FROM A VETERINARIAN REGARDING THE EXAMINATION AND INOCULATION OF SAID ANIMAL.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.
Section 6 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 328 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 6. Quarantine of Biting Animals.

- Α. When any animal bites a human within the County, the owner of such animal shall immediately place the animal in quarantine, or the Animal Control Officer or any peace officer may seize such animal, whether on or off the owner's premises, and place the animal in quarantine for such period of time as may be ordered by the Animal Control Officer. The animal to be quarantined shall be placed in confinement with a licensed veterinarian in a veterinary hospital or other place of quarantine approved by the District Health Office, and such quarantine shall be at the owner's expense. Home quarantine may be authorized by the Animal Control Officer or persons duly authorized under his supervision, under the following conditions: the owner must show a current vaccination certificate against rabies as defined in Section 2, and the quarantine holding facilities must be approved for isolating the animal from public contact.
- B. Any animal quarantined shall remain in quarantine for such period of time as the Animal Control

Officer shall order, not to exceed six (6) months, and such animal shall not be released until a written release is issued by the Animal Control Officer.

C. The owner of any animal placed in quarantine shall present to the Animal Control Officer a written statement executed by a veterinarian that the animal has been examined and found to be free of the signs or symptoms of rabies and has received inoculation against rabies as referred to under Section 2.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
