Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 548, Ordinance No. 379, an ordinance amending Washoe County Ordinance No. 202 entitled "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE WASHOE COUNTY SHERIFF TO ISSUE PERMITS TO CARRY CONCEALED WEAPONS OR TO POSSESS AND TRANSPORT ANY SHELL, CARTRIDGE, BOMB, OR WEAPON CONTAINING OR CAPABLE OF EMITTING TEAR, GAS, OR ANY WEAPON DESIGNED FOR THE USE OF SUCH SHELL, CARTRIDGE, OR BOMB; ESTABLISHING AN APPLICATION FEE FOR SUCH PERMITS; PROVIDING AND FOR ANNUAL RENEWAL THEREOF; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO BY RAISING THE FEE CHARGED FOR OBTAINING A PERMIT TO CARRY A CONCEALED WEAPON OR TO POSSESS AND TRANSPORT ANY SHELL, CARTRIDGE, BOMB, OR WEAPON CONTAINING ON CAPABLE OF EMITTING TEAR GAS, OR ANY WEAPON DESIGNED FOR THE USE OF SUCH SHELL, CARTRIDGE, OR BOMB FROM \$15 TO \$22," was adopted on May 2, 1978, by Commissioners Rusk, Nelson, Farr, Stoess and Brown.

SUMMARY:

Amends Washoe County Ordinance No. 202 by raising the fee charged for obtaining a permit to carry a concealed weapon or to possess and transport any shell, cartridge, bomb or weapon containing or capable of emitting tear gas, or any weapon designed for the use of such shell, cartridge, or bomb from \$15 to \$22.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE WASHOE COUNTY SHERIFF TO ISSUE PERMITS TO CARRY CONCEALED WEAPONS OR TO POSSESS AND TRANSPORT ANY SHELL, CARTRIDGE, BOMB, OR WEAPON CONTAINING OR CAPABLE OF EMITTING TEAR GAS, OR ANY WEAPON DESIGNED FOR THE USE OF SUCH SHELL, CARTRIDGE, OR BOMB; ESTABLISHING AN APPLICATION FEE FOR SUCH PERMITS; PROVIDING AND FOR ANNUAL RENEWAL THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR THE REVOCATION THEREOF; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO" BY RAISING THE FEE CHARGED FOR OBTAINING A PERMIT TO CARRY A CONCEALED WEAPON OR TO POSSESS AND TRANSPORT ANY SHELL, CARTRIDGE, BOMB, OR WEAPON CONTAINING OR CAPABLE OF EMITTING TEAR GAS, OR ANY WEAPON DESIGNED FOR THE USE OF SUCH SHELL, CARTRIDGE, OR BOMB FROM \$15 TO \$22.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.
Section 3 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 202 is hereby repealed and the following language is inserted in its stead:

## SECTION 3.

- A. Upon the application for any permit to carry a concealed weapon, or to possess or transport any such shell, cartridge, or bomb or weapon designed for the use of such shell, cartridge, or bomb, the Sheriff and/or his authorized representative shall collect from the applicant a fee of Seven Dollars (\$7.00) for deposit into the general fund of Washoe County. Said fee shall be for the purposes of conducting an investigation into the background of the applicant to determine whether the applicant is a fit candidate for receiving said permit. The Seven Dollar (\$7.00) fee shall be nonrefundable
- B. Upon the issuance to the applicant of any permit to carry a concealed weapon or to possess or transport any such shell, cartridge, or bomb or weapon designed for use of such shell, cartridge, or bomb, the Sheriff and/or his designated representative shall collect from the applicant an additional fee of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for deposit into the general fund of Washoe County.
- C. Said permit shall be valid for a period not to exceed one (1) year and may be renewed annually. Upon renewal of said permit, the Sheriff and/or his designated representative shall collect a Fifteen Dollar (\$15.00) permit fee for deposit into the general fund of Washoe County.

SECTION 2.
This ordinance shall take effect after its proposal, passage and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
