Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 562, Ordinance No. 394, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WASHOE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 83, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING. THE DESIGN, ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION, ENLARGEMENT, ALTERATION, REPAIR, MOVING, REMOVAL, CONVERSION, DEMOLITION, COLUPANCY, EQUIPMENT, USE, HEIGHT, AREA; MAINTENANCE, EXCAVATION AND FOUNDATION OF ANY BUILDING OR STRUCTURE IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS, COLLECTION OF FEES, AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE INCORPORATED HEREIN; PROVIDING A METHOD FOR THE CLASSIFICATION AND ABATEMENT OF ANY UNSAFE AND DANGEROUS BUILDING OR STRUCTURE WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; ADOPTING A SPECIAL SET OF REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO CONSTRUCTION OF ANY ONE-STORY OR TWO-STORY DWELLING OF STUD WALL OR MASONRY CONSTRUCTION IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR INSULATION INSPECTIONS PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF NRS 341.260; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF ANY REGULATION ADOPTED HEREIN; AND REPEALING ALL OR MASON PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF ANY REGULATION ADOPTED HEREIN; AND REPEALING ALL OR MASON PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF ANY REGULATION ADOPTED HEREIN; AND REPEALING ALL OR MASON PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF THE ENERGY CONSERVATION STANDARDS FOR NEW BUILDING CONSTRUCTION OF THE ENERGY CONSERVATION STANDARDS FOR NEW BUILDING CONSTRUCTION OF THE STANDARDS, WAS ADOPTED OR OR AUGUST 8, 1978 by Commissioners Rusk, Nelson, Farr, Stoess and Brown.

SUMMARY:

Amends Washoe County Ordinance No. 83 by amending the title of the Ordinance; provides for adoption of the Energy Conservation Standards for New Building Construction established by the State Public Works Board; and amends the Ordinance to reflect the adoption of those standards.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DESIGN, ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION, ENLARGEMENT, ALTERATION, REPAIR, MOVING, REMOVAL, CONVERSION, DEMOLITION, OCCUPANCY, EQUIPMENT, USE, HEIGHT, AREA, MAINTENANCE, EXCAVATION AND FOUNDATION OF ANY BUILDING OR STRUCTURE IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS, COLLECTION OF FEES, AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE UNIFORM BUILD-ING CODE INCORPORATED HEREIN; PROVIDING A METHOD FOR THE CLASSIFICATION AND ABATEMENT OF ANY UNSAFE AND DANGEROUS BUILDING OR STRUCTURE WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; ADOPTING A SPECIAL SET OF REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO CONSTRUCTION OF ANY ONE-STORY OR TWO-STORY DWELLING OF STUD WALL OR MASONRY CONSTRUCTION IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR INSULATION INSPECTIONS PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF NRS 341.260; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF ANY REGULATION ADOPTED HEREIN; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO" BY AMENDING THE TITLE OF THE ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF THE ENERGY CONSERVATION STANDARDS FOR NEW BUILDING CONSTRUCTION ESTABLISHED BY THE STATE PUBLIC WORKS BOARD; AND AMENDING THE ORDINANCE TO REFLECT THE ADOPTION OF THOSE STANDARDS.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

 $\frac{\text{SECTION 1}}{\text{The title of Washoe County Ordinance No. 83 is hereby amended to read as follows:}$

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DESIGN, ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION, ENLARGEMENT, ALTERATION, REPAIR, MOVING, REMOVAL, CONVER-SION, DEMOLITION, OCCUPANCY, EQUIPMENT, USE, HEIGHT, AREA, MAINTENANCE, EXCAVATION AND FOUNDATION OF ANY BUILDING OR STRUCTURE IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; PRO-VIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS, COLLECTION OF FEES, AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE INCORPORATED HEREIN; PROVIDING A METHOD FOR THE CLASSIFICATION AND ABATE-MENT OF ANY UNSAFE AND DANGEROUS BUILDING OR STRUCTURE WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; ADOPTING A SPECIAL SET OF REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO CONSTRUCTION FOF ANY ONE-STORY OR TWO-STORY DWELLING OF STUD WALL OR MASONRY CONSTRUCTION IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; ADOPTING THE ENERGY CONSERVATION STANDARDS FOR NEW BUILDING CONSTRUCTION ESTABLISHED BY THE STATE PUBLIC WORKS BOARD; PROVIDING FOR INSULATION INSPECTIONS PURSUANT TO THOSE STANDARDS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF ANY REGULATION OR STANDARD ADOPTED HEREIN; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH: AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

 $\frac{\text{SECTION 2}}{\text{Section 1}}$ of Washoe County Ordinance No. 83 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- The following codes and standards are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference in this Ordinance:
 - (a) The 1975 edition of the "One and Two Family Dwelling Code" approved and published by the International Conference of Building Officials;
 - (b) The 1976 edition of the "Uniform Building Code,"
 "Uniform Housing Code" and "Uniform Code for the
 Abatement of Dangerous Buildings" approved and
 published by the International Conference of Building Officials; and
 - (c) The "Energy Conservation Standards for New Building Construction" established by the State Public Works Board.
- 2. As used in the above-listed codes:
 - (a) "City," "municipality" and other similar terms shall be construed to mean Washoe County;
 - (b) "City Council" shall be construed to mean the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County;
 - (c) "Mayor" shall be construed to mean the Chairman or acting Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County;
 - (d) "City Clerk" shall be construed to mean the Washoe County Clerk; and
 - (e) Whenever any other term is found which refers to a public official who is charged with administering a particular provision of a code, the term shall be construed to mean the public official of Washoe County charged with administering the particular provision in question.
- 3. The provisions contained in the above-listed codes and standards and the amendments thereto set forth as Exhibits A, B and C of this Ordinance shall be adhered to in the design, erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, moving, removal, conversion, demolition, occupancy, equipment, use, height, area, maintenance, excavation and foundation of any building or other structure in the unincorporated area of Washoe County.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION 3}}$. Section 3 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 83 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any person, firm, association or corporation:

 Violating any provision contained in any code or standard listed in Subsection 1 of Section 1 of this Ordinance; Violating any provision contained in Exhibit A, B or C of this Ordinance;

is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500. Each day of violation constitutes a separate offense.

SECTION 4. Exhibit A of Washoe County Ordinance No. 83 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 304. (d) Required Inspections. Amended to read as follows:

(d) Required Inspections. Reinforcing steel or structural framework of any part of any building or structure shall not be covered or concealed without first obtaining the approval of the Building Official.

The Building Official, upon notification from the permit holder or his agent, shall make the following inspections and shall either approve that portion of the construction as completed or shall notify the permit holder or his agent wherein the same fails to comply with the Code.

- 1. FOUNDATION INSPECTION: To be made after trenches are excavated and forms erected and when all materials for the foundation are delivered on the job. Where concrete from a central mixing plant (commonly termed "transit mixed") is to be used, materials need not be on the job.
- 2. FRAME INSPECTION: To be made after the roof, all framing, fire blocking, and bracing are in place and all pipes, chimneys, vents, rough plumbing and rough electrical are complete.
- 3. INSULATION INSPECTION: To be made after rough framing, rough plumbing and rough electrical inspections have been made and approved. Insulation is to be inspected for compliance with the energy conservation standards for new building construction established by the State Public Works Board.
- 4. LATH AND/OR WALLBOARD INSPECTION: To be made after all lathing and/or wallboard, interior and exterior, is in place; but before any plastering is applied or before wallboard joints and fasteners are taped and finished.
- 5. FINAL INSPECTION: To be made after building is completed and ready for occupany.

 $\underline{\text{Exhibit A}}$ of Washoe County Ordinance No. 83 is hereby further amended by repeal of the following paragraph:

All references in the 1976 Editions of the "Uniform Building Code," "Uniform Housing Code," "Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings," and the 1975 Edition of the "One and Two Family

Dwelling Code" incorporated by this ordinance that refer to "City," "municipality" and the like shall be construed to mean the County of Washoe. Where the word "City Council" appears, it shall be construed to mean the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County. Where the word "Mayor" appears, it shall be construed to mean the Chairman or acting Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County. Where the word "City Clerk" appears, it shall be construed to mean the Washoe County Clerk. Wherever other words appear in the Volumes in question referring to public officials charged with the responsibility of administering a particular provision of the Code in question, such as Director of Public Works or Building Official, it shall be construed to mean that official or employee of Washoe County charged with the responsibility of carrying out the duties of the office in question, as defined or referred to in the aforesaid Uniform Building Code.

SECTION $\underline{6}$. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
