 $\frac{\text{SECTION 1:}}{\text{Section 2}}$ of Washoe County Ordinance No. 103 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The terms of office of members to the Board of Adjustment shall be for a period of five years, expiring on June 30th, or until their successor takes office, provided, however, terms of the first Board appointed after the effective date of this Ordinance shall be for 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 years.
