ORDINANCE NO. 457

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING STANDARDS FOR USE IN DETERMINING WHICH STREET INTERSECTIONS IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY REQUIRE INSTALLATION OF STREET LIGHTS; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO," BY EXPANDING THE STANDARDS UTILIZED IN DETERMINING THE NEED FOR THE INSTALLATION OF CERTAIN STREET LIGHTS AT CERTAIN HAZARDOUS LOCATIONS IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The title of Washoe County Ordinance No. 295 is hereby amended to read as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING STANDARDS FOR USE IN DETERMINING THE STREET INTERSECTIONS OR OTHER HAZARDOUS LOCATIONS IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF WASHOE COUNTY WHICH MAY REQUIRE THE INSTALLATION OF STREET LIGHTS; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

 $\frac{\text{SECTION 2}}{\text{Section 1}}$ of Washoe County Ordinance 295 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. Purpose.
The purpose of this ordinance is to safeguard the public safety and general welfare by establishing standards for use by the officers and employees of Washoe County in determining which street intersections and hazardous locations in the unincorporated area of Washoe County require installation of street lights.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION 3}}$. Section 2 of Washoe County Ordinance 295 is hereby amended to read as follows:

<u>SECTION 2</u>. Definitions.

- A. "Accident" means any collision between any motor vehicle, as that term is defined in NRS 482.135, with any other motor vehicle, bicycle or pedestrian.
- B. "Night" means the hours between dusk and dawn.
- C. "Satellite Community" means any isolated county community which is served by a minimum of six (6) internal street intersections.
- D. "Street intersection" means that area at which County maintained streets or roadways intersect with any other public street or roadway.
- E. "Traffic Control Committee" means that committee created by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners on August 25, 1971.

 $\frac{\text{SECTION 4}}{\text{Section 3}}$ of Washoe County Ordinance 295 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Standards.

- A. Any street intersection within the unincorporated area of Washoe County at which two out of the following six conditions exist may be required to be lighted at night by County-installed street lights.
 - 1. Four or more accidents have occurred at night at the intersection in any one twelve (12) month period of time, or six (6) or more accidents have occurred at night at the intersection in any twenty-four (24) month period of time.
 - 2. In the opinion of the Traffic Control Committee the combination of sight distance, roadway alignment, grades, channelization, or other factors constitute a confusing or dangerous condition if such intersection is not illuminated.
 - 3. At night, there is a significant volume of pedestrian traffic in crosswalks adjacent to frequently used public gathering places.
 - 4. An average daily traffic of at least five hundred (500) motor vehicles exist at such intersection, as determined from a survey made of any single week's traffic at such intersection.
 - 5. Street lights for a satellite community will be of aid to emergency vehicles, to pedestrian traffic in designated crosswalks, and to drivers unfamiliar with the satellite community.
 - 6. Tee, single right angle, four way stop, or signalized intersections.
- B. Street lights may be required to be installed at hazardous locations including but not limited to, sharp curves, alignment of bridge approaches, railroad crossings, short sight distances and changes in number of traffic lanes or lane separations if it is determined by the Traffic Control Committee that street lights would improve safety.

SECTION 5.
Section 4 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 295 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4. Traffic Control Committee, Engineer, Duties.

- A. It shall be the duty of the Traffic Control Committee to determine if a street intersection or hazardous condition warrants the installation of a street light under the conditions specified in Section 3 of this ordinance.
- B. The type of street lighting, intensity of lighting, and placement of lighting required by this ordinance shall be determined by the Washoe County Engineer after a street light need has been determined by the Traffic Control Committee.

SECTION 6.
Section 5 of Washoe County Ordinance 295 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 5. Applicability
The provisions of this ordinance shall be in no way supersede those provisions regarding installation of street lights by a subdivider in a subdivision as set forth in Washoe County Ordinance No. 51, and the provisions of that ordinance shall take precedence over the provisions of this ordinance with regard to lighting of streets in subdivisions.

SECTION 7.
Section 6 of Washoe County Ordinance 295 is hereby repealed.
