

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE CREATING COUNTY COMMISSION-ER DISTRICTS BASED UPON POPULATION IN WASHOE COUNTY, NEVADA, IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT REAPPORTIONMENT LAW; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO", BY REVISING CERTAIN COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS TO INCLUDE PARTIAL ASSEMBLY DISTRICTS.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Section 1 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 276 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1.

As used in this Ordinance "Assembly Districts" means those Washoe County assembly districts created by NRS 218.080(1).

SECTION 2.

Section 2 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 276 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2.

In compliance with Chapter 244 of NRS and the Local Government Reapportionment Law, five County Commissioner Districts in Washoe County, Nevada, are hereby created as follows:

- A. County Commissioner District No. 1 is composed of Assembly Districts No. 24 and No. 25.
- B. County Commissioner District No. 2 is composed of Assembly Districts No. 23, No. 26 and that portion of No. 37 lying within Washoe County.
- C. County Commissioner District No. 3 is composed of Assembly Districts No. 27 and No. 28.
- D. County Commissioner District No. 4 is composed of Assembly Districts No. 30 and No. 31.
- E. County Commissioner District No. 5 is composed of Assembly Districts No. 29, No. 32 and that portion of No. 34 lying within Washoe County.

SECTION 3.

Section 3 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 276 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3.

- A. At the General Election in 1976 and every four years thereafter, there shall be elected one County Commissioner from County Commissioner District No. 1 and one County Commissioner from County Commissioner District No. 4, for terms of four years.
- B. At the General Election in 1978 and every four years thereafter, there shall be elected one County Commissioner from County Commissioner District No. 2, one County Commissioner from County Commissioner District No. 3, and one County Commissioner from County Commissioner District No. 5, for terms of four years.
- C. The members of the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, Nevada, as constituted on the effective date of this Ordinance, shall, pursuant to law, continue to hold office for the terms for which they were elected and shall represent the following County Commissioner Districts:
 - Commissioner Belie Williams shall be the Commissioner representing County Commissioner District No. 1.
 - 2. Commissioner Bennie Ferrari shall be the Commissioner representing County Commissioner District No. 2.
 - 3. Commissioner Jim Underwood shall be the Commissioner representing County Commissioner District No. 3.
 - 4. Commissioner Bill Farr shall be the Commissioner representing County Commissioner District No. 4.
 - 5. Commissioner Steve Brown shall be the Commissioner representing County Commissioner District No. 5.

SECTION 4.

Section 4 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 276 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4.

If a vacancy occurs in the office of any County Commissioner before the expiration of the term of that Commissioner, the vacancy shall be filled according to

law by appointment of a qualified elector from the District which that Commissioner represented.

SECTION 5.

Section 5 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 276 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 6.

Section 6 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 276 is hereby repealed.
