ORDINANCE NO. 5/5

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 1978 EDITION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, TOGETHER WITH SUCH CHANGES AS ARE NECESSARY TO MAKE THE SAME APPLICABLE TO CONDITIONS IN WASHOE COUNTY AND SUCH OTHER CHANGES AS ARE DESIRABLE, RELATING TO GENERAL PROVISIONS, WIRING METHODS AND MATERIALS, EQUIPMENT FOR GENERAL USE, SPECIAL OCCUPANCIES, EQUIPMENT AND CONDITIONS AND COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; REPEALING COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 84, AS AMENDED; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO" BY INCREASING SERVICE FEES FOR ISSUING PERMITS AND MAKING INSPECTIONS.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Section 90-11 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 391 is hereby amended to read as follows:

90-11 Service fees for permits for new construction.

- (a) Residential (Single or Multifamily). Service fees listed below in this paragraph for new residential construction include all electrical installations when the formula is applied to the square footage of area:
 - (1) Two cents per square foot and \$5 for issuance of a permit, plus the additional fee imposed by paragraph (d).
 - (2) One cent per square foot for detached or attached garages on the same service, plus the additional fee imposed by paragraph (d).
- (b) Commercial, Industrial, Assembly Building and All Alterations. One cent per square foot plus the additional fee imposed by paragraph (d), provided, however, that the minimum service fee for issuing a permit is \$5 plus the additional fee imposed by paragraph (d).
- (c) Incidental fee schedule. The minimum service fee for issuing any electrical permit is \$5 and the incidentals listed in this paragraph, plus the additional fee imposed by paragraph (d).

NOTE: For any electrial work for which a permit is required but for which no fee is herein provided, an inspection fee at the rate of \$ 16 per hour per man, and 10 cents per mile on a round-trip basis, plus the additional fee imposed by paragraph (d), will be charged.

(d) Additional Service Fees.

- (1) An additional service fee in the amount of 9.9 percent of the basic service fee must be paid upon issuance of any permit or upon any inspection required pursuant to this Code.
- (2) If first approved in the manner required by section 5 of Chapter 150, Statutes of Nevada, 1981, an additional annual service fee in the amount of 9.9 percent of the basic service fee must be paid in 1982, and cumulatively each

year thereafter, upon issuance of any permit or upon an inspection required by this Code.
