SUMMARY: Increases service fees for issuing heating, cooling and ventilation permits under the Uniform Mechanical Code.

BILL NO. <u>688</u> ORDINANCE NO. <u>517</u>

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE OF WASHOE COUNTY PRO-VIDING FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY BY PRESCRIBING MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR THE USE, DESIGN, INSTALLA-TION AND MAINTENANCE OF HEATING, VENTILATING, COMFORT COOLING AND REFRIGERATION SYSTEMS AND EQUIPMENT; REQUIRING A PERMIT AND INSPECTION FOR THE INSTALLATION, ALTERATION AND REPLACEMENT OF SAID EQUIPMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCE-MENT OF SUCH REQUIREMENTS; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO," BY INCREASING SERVICE FEES FOR ISSUING HEATING, COOLING AND VENTILATION PERMITS UNDER THE UNIFORM MECHANICAL CODE.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Exhibit A of Washoe County Ordinance No. 86 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following changes, additions and deletions to Chapter 3 of the 1976 Edition of the Uniform Mechanical Code.

SEC. 304. Amend by deleting and adding in the place of this paragraph the following:

(a) Any person desiring a permit required by this Code shall, at the time of filing an application therefore, pay the service fee for the issuance of the permit as required by this paragraph plus the additional fee required by paragraph (b).

- - (b) An additional fee in the amount of 9.9 percent of the basic service fee must be paid upon application for any permit required by this Code.

If first approved in the manner provided by Section 5 of Chapter 150, Statutes of Nevada, 1981, an additional annual service fee in the amount of 9.9 percent of the basic service fee must be paid in 1982, and cumulatively each year thereafter, upon application for any permit required by this Code.
