


ORDINANCE NO. 533

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE AMOUNT OF COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO CERTAIN ELECTION BOARD OFFICERS", BY INCREASING THE COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN ELECTION BOARD OFFICERS.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 117 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 1. Except as provided in subsection 2:
 - (a) Foremen and voting board chairmen shall each receive \$75 for all services performed at each election.
 - (b) Other election board workers shall each receive:
 - (1) \$60 if they perform services for 8 hours or more at each election; or
 - (2) \$5 for each hour or fraction thereof that they perform services for less than 8 hours at each election, but in no event may they receive less than \$25 for such services.
- 2. Any person who:
 - (a) Is employed by, and on the regular payroll of, the Registrar of Voters; and
 - (b) Performs services as an election board officer at any election;

shall receive his usual compensation as such an employee in lieu of the compensation specified in subsection 1.

SECTION 2. Sections 4 and 5 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 117 are hereby repealed.
