SUMMARY: Provides for increasing the maximum fines for violation of county ordinances effective upon the adoption of the Washoe County Code.

BILL NO. 705

ORDINANCE NO. 534

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE MAXIMUM FINES FOR VIOLATIONS OF WASHOE COUNTY ORDINANCES TO BE EFFECTIVE UPON THE ADOPTION OF THE WASHOE COUNTY CODE; DIRECTING THAT THE INDIVIDUAL PREPARING THE REVISION AND CODIFICATION OF THE COUNTY CODE MAKE THE NECESSARY CHANGES IN THE PENALTY SECTIONS OF THE COUNTY CODE TO REFLECT THE AMENDMENTS TO NRS EFFECTED BY CHAPTER 350, STATUTES OF NEVADA 1981; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, Nevada, has heretofore contracted for the revision and codification of the general ordinances of Washoe County; and

WHEREAS, The revision and codification of the general ordinances of Washoe County (to be known as the Washoe County Code) are nearing completion and, pursuant to statute, include restatements and substantive changes as are necessary for clarity and consistency; and

WHEREAS, By the enactment of chapter 350, Statutes of Nevada 1981, the Nevada Legislature amended NRS 193.120 and 193.150, increasing the maximum fines for misdemeanors, which amendments should be reflected in the various penalty sections of the general ordinances of the county; and

WHEREAS, It is both economical and expeditious to effect such penalty changes in the general ordinances of the county required by the enactment of chapter 350, Statutes of Nevada 1981, by directing changes to be made in the Washoe County Code prior to its adoption by the individual contracted with to prepare the revision and codification; now, therefore,

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Russell W. McDonald, who has contracted with the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, Nevada, to revise and codify the general ordinances of Washoe County and prepare the text for the Washoe County Code, is hereby authorized and directed to make necessary changes in the various penalty sections of the Washoe County Code, prior to its enactment, to reflect the pertinent provisions of chapter 350, Statutes of Nevada 1981.
