ORDINANCE NO. 582

AN ORDINANCE INITIATING PROCEEDINGS FOR THE ADDING OF THE BASIC POWER OF FURNISHING A SPECIFIC RECREATION FACILITY TO THE HORIZON HILLS GENERAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR WRITTEN NOTICE OF HEARING AND HEARING ON THE ADDITION OF THE BASIC POWER.

WHEREAS, the County of Washoe, in the State of Nevada, is a County incorporated and operating under the laws of the State of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County, hereinafter designated as the "Board", is authorized and empowered under NRS 318.077, in addition to powers elsewhere conferred upon the Board, to add basic powers to a general improvement district.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE, IN THE STATE OF NEVADA, DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Proceedings are hereby initiated for the addition of a basic power to the Horizon Hills General Improvement District, hereinafter designated as the "District", pursuant to Chapter 318, Title 25 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

SECTION 2.

The basic power to be added to the District is as follows:

- (a) Subject to the provisions of subsection b., the District may acquire, construct, reconstruct, improve, extend and better lands, works and systems for a specific recreation facility.
- (b) If the proposed recreational facility is situated within 7 miles from the boundary of an incorporated city or unincorporated town, and if the County has adopted a recreation plan pursuant to NRS 278.010 to 278.630, inclusive, the authority conferred by subsection a may be exercised only in conformity with such plan.
- (c) Such recreational facility is to be a public park.

SECTION 3.

The general description of the boundaries of the District are the coterminous exterior boundaries of the composite and consolidated area consisting of the several parcels of land described in the exhibit entitled Exhibit "A" hereto attached and by reference made a part hereof.

SECTION 4.

The lands within the District are within seven miles from the boundaries of the City of Reno, an incorporated city of the State of Nevada. Accordingly, all members of the Board have unanimously agreed to the initiating of the proceedings for the adding of the basic power to the District, as permitted by NRS 318.055.

SECTION 5.

Tuesday, October 25, 1983, at the hour of 9:45 o'clock a.m., in the Chambers of the Board, 1205 Mill Street, Reno, Nevada, is hereby fixed as the time and place when and where the Board will have a hearing on the adding of the basic power to the District, after which the Board will make its findings whether or not the ordinance adding the basic power to the District is required by necessity and public convenience and whether or not the adding of the basic power is economically sound and feasible. All interested persons may be heard at the hearing.

SECTION 6.

The County Clerk shall mail written notice to all property owners within the District of the intention of the Board to add the basic power to the District. The notice shall set forth the name, statement of purpose, general description and time and place of hearing.
