ORDINANCE NO. 689

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WASHOE COUNTY CODE BY REVISING PROVISIONS WHICH ESTABLISH THE MINIMUM BID FOR SALES OF TAX-DELINQUENT PROPERTIES.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 20.473 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows.

20.473 Bids: Amounts; procedure.

- 1. Except as provided in subsection 2, no bid less than an amount equal to the sum of the delinquent taxes, costs of sale, penalties and interest, or an amount equal to the assessed value of the taxdelinquent property subject to sale, whichever is greater, shall be accepted by the county treasurer.
- 2. If the county treasurer finds that a property subject to sale is burdened by a legal or physical restraint upon its development which may inhibit bidders from bidding on the property, he may accept a bid of no less than an amount equal to the sum of the delinquent taxes, costs of sale, penalties and interest.
- 3. All sales shall be made subject to existing rights-of-way and easements of Washoe County, the City of Reno, the City of Sparks or the State of Nevada.
- 4. If the required base bid is \$500 or less, bidding increments shall be \$25. If the required base bid is more than \$500, the bidding increment shall be \$50.
- 5. If, during the bidding, one bidder offers another bidder a consideration to cease bidding, the bid and any subsequent bids of the bidder offering the consideration shall be disregarded by the county treasurer and may not be accepted.
