ORDINANCE NO. 694

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WASHOE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 605 BY EXTENDING THE EXPIRATION DATE THEREOF.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Findings.

- 1. The board finds that Ordinance No. 605, which became effective on June 25, 1984, has an expiration date of July 1, 1986, and will expire on that date unless a modified version of that ordinance is adopted before that date or unless the expiration date of that ordinance is extented.
- 2. The board finds that it is in the process of adopting a modified version of the massage ordinance, but that final adoption will not occur before July 1, 1986.
- 3. The board finds that the health, safety and welfare of the public requires that the present provisions remain in effect until such time as a new ordinance can be formally adopted.
- SECTION 2. Expiration date extended. The expiration date of July 1, 1986 contained in section 20 of Ordinance 605 is hereby extended for a period of 60 days, or until a new ordinance amending Ordinance 605 is adopted and becomes effective, whichever date is earlier.
- <u>SECTION 3.</u> <u>Effective date.</u> This emergency ordinance becomes effective upon passage.
