AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ACQUISITION AND FINANCING OF CERTAIN LAND AND A BUILDING THEREON AND CERTAIN COMPUTER AND TELEPHONE EQUIPMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION DELIVERY OF AN INSTALLMENT **PURCHASE** AGREEMENT, DEED OF TRUST, SECURITY AGREEMENT, FINANCING STATEMENT AND DECLARATION OF TRUST. CONTRACT OF PURCHASE AND OFFICIAL STATEMENT: RATIFYING ACTION PREVIOUSLY TAKEN IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH TRANSACTION; AND PRESCRIBING DETAILS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO.

WHEREAS, Washoe County, Nevada (the "County") is authorized pursuant to Section 244.275, Nevada Revised Statutes, to purchase real and personal property necessary for use by the County; and

WHEREAS, the County is authorized pursuant to Sections 244.320 and 350.800, Nevada Revised Statutes, to enter into agreements such as installment purchase agreements to provide for the acquisition and financing of real and personal property necessary for use by the County; and

WHEREAS, the County has pursuant to Section 244.275, Nevada Revised Statutes, previously entered into a Lease Agreement with Option to Purchase dated May 24, 1983, with respect to certain land (the "Site") and a building thereon (the "Building"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County (the "Board") has determined, and hereby determines, that is necessary and in the best interests of the County that the County enter into an installment purchase agreement in order to acquire the Site, the Building and certain computer and telephone equipment (the "Equipment") for use by the County; and

WHEREAS, for purposes of financing the acquisition of the Site, the Building and the Equipment (collectively, the "Project"), the Board has determined, and hereby determines, that it is in the best interests of the County that the County enter into the Installment Purchase Agreement, Deed of Trust, Security Agreement, Financing Statement and Declaration of Trust (the "Agreement"), in substantially the form presented to the Board, to provide for the acquisition and financing of the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Sections 244.320 and 350.800, Nevada Revised Statutes, the obligation of the County under the Agreement is extinguished (except to the extent it can be paid from the proceeds of a foreclosure or other sale of the Project and from other moneys as provided in the Agreement) by failure of the Board to appropriate money for the ensuing fiscal year for payment of amounts due in such fiscal year under the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Certificates of Participation (the "Certificates") will be executed and delivered pursuant to the Agreement and sold pursuant to a Contract of Purchase (the "Purchase Contract"), in substantially the form presented to the Board; and

WHEREAS, there will be executed and distributed in connection with the sale of the Certificates an Official Statement (the "Official Statement"), in substantially the form presented to the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE, IN THE STATE OF NEVADA, DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. All action (not inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance) heretofore taken by the Board and the officers of the County directed toward the Project, be, and the same is hereby, ratified, approved and confirmed.

Section 2. The Board hereby finds and determines that the acquisition of the Project under the terms and provisions set forth in the Agreement and, with respect to the Site and Building, at the price set forth in the Lease Agreement with Option to Purchase dated May 24, 1983, is necessary, convenient, and in the best interests of the County; and the Board hereby authorizes such acquisition of the Project under the terms and provisions of the Agreement.

Section 3. The forms, terms and provisions of the Agreement and the Purchase Contract be and they hereby are approved and the County shall enter into the Agreement and the Purchase Contract in substantially the forms of such documents presented to the Board, with such changes therein as are consistent with the facts and are not inconsistent herewith; and the Chairman of the Board is hereby authorized to execute and deliver the Agreement and the Purchase Contract, and the County Clerk is hereby authorized to affix the County seal to and to attest the Agreement and the Purchase Contract.

Section 4. The Board hereby acknowledges and consents to the execution and delivery of the Certificates pursuant to the Agreement. The County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to affix her signature and the County seal, or facsimiles thereof, to authenticate the Certificates, in substantially the form contained in the Agreement.

Section 5. The Official Statement, in substantially the form presented to the Board, is in all respects approved and authorized. The Chairman of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to affix his signature to the Official Statement in

substantially the form and with substantially the same content as presented to the Board, for and on behalf of the County. The distribution by First Interstate Bank of California of the Preliminary Official Statement relating to the Certificates and presented to the Board, is hereby ratified; and the distribution by such firm of the Official Statement, in substantially the form presented to this meeting, to prospective purchasers of the Certificates is hereby approved.

Section 6. The Board hereby determines and declares that the term of the Agreement (after taking into account the release provisions relating to the Equipment contained in Section 13.2 of the Agreement) does not exceed the useful life of the Project.

Section 7. No provision of this ordinance, the Agreement, the Purchase Contract, the Certificates or the Official Statement shall be construed as creating or constituting a general obligation indebtedness of the County within the meaning of any provision of the laws of the State of Nevada concerning or limiting the creation of general obligation indebtedness by the County.

Section 8. The officers of the County be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this ordinance, and to carry out the transactions contemplated by this ordinance and the Agreement.

Section 9. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or resolution, or part thereof, heretofore repealed.

Section 10. In accordance with Section 244.100, Nevada Revised Statutes, this ordinance when first proposed is to be read by title to the Board, immediately after which at least one copy of the proposed ordinance is to be filed with the office of

the County Clerk for public examination; thereafter, the County Clerk is authorized and directed to give notice of the filing, together with the title and an adequate summary of the ordinance and the date upon which a public hearing will be held on such ordinance, by publication at least once in the Reno Gazette-Journal, i.e., a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County, at least ten days before the date set for such hearing, i.e., at least ten days before December 23, 1986, such publication to be in substantially the following form:

An adequate summary of the ordinance is as follows:

The preambles of the ordinance recite that the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") deems it necessary to acquire a certain site, a building thereon and certain computer and telephone equipment (collectively, the "Project"); recite that the Board has determined to acquire the Project pursuant to the terms of an Installment Purchase Agreement, Deed of Trust, Security Agreement, Financing Statement and Declaration of Trust (the "Agreement"); recite that the County's obligation under the is extinguished (to the extent payable from appropriated moneys of the County) by failure of the Board to appropriate money for the ensuing fiscal year; recite that certificates of participation (the "Certificates") will be delivered under the Agreement and sold pursuant to a Contract of Purchase (the "Purchase Contract"); and recite that an Official Statement will be distributed in connection with the sale of the Certificates.

The ordaining clause is then set forth.

Section 1 ratifies consistent action previously taken by the Board or the officers of the County.

Section 2 sets forth the Board's findings as to the acquisition of the Project.

Section 3 approves the form, terms and provisions of the Agreement and the Purchase Contract and directs execution thereof.

Section 4 acknowledges and consents to the delivery of the Certificates and directs the County Clerk to authenticate the Certificates.

Section 5 approves the form of the Official Statement; directs the execution thereof, ratifies the distribution of the Preliminary Official Statement with respect to the Certificates and approves the distribution of the Official Statement.

Section 6 sets forth the determination of the Board that the term of the Agreement does not exceed the useful life of the Project.

Section 7 states that neither the ordinance, the Agreement, the Purchase Contract, the Certificates, nor the Official Statement create or constitute general obligation indebtedness of the County.

Sections 8 and 9 authorize the County officials to take any action necessary to effectuate the ordinance; and provide a repealer clause for conflicting provisions.

Sections 10, 11 and 12 provide for notice by publication of the December 23, 1986, hearing on the ordinance, and for this summary of the provisions of the ordinance; provide that the ordinance shall be in effect from and after its publication for two weeks following its final adoption on December 23, 1986; provide the form for such publication which includes the names of the Commissioners voting for and against the adoption of the ordinance; and provide a severability clause.

Copies of Bill No. ____ are on file in the office of the Washoe County Clerk at the Washoe County Courthouse, Virginia and Court Streets, Reno, Nevada, for public examination. The Board shall adopt or reject the ordinance (or the ordinance as amended) within 35 days after the date of the final public hearing.
