SUMMARY: Amends Washoe County Code by revising provisions concerning family home child care.

BILL NO. <u>252</u>

ORDINANCE NO. 777

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WASHOE COUNTY CODE BY REVISING PROVISIONS CONCERNING REGISTRATION OF FAMILY HOME CHILD CARE.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Chapter 45 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended by the addition of a new section to read as follows:

45.097 Investigation by sheriff, fees

- 1. Upon request by the department, the sheriff shall conduct such investigation as is reasonably necessary to determine whether the applicant and all adults 18 years or older who reside in or are engaged in the operation of a registered home are qualified to be issued a family home child care registration certificate.
- 2. The sheriff may charge an applicant a reasonable fee in excess of the registration fee, where the circumstances mandate a more extensive investigation than is normally required.
- 3. The sheriff shall, after completing the investigation, make a report thereon to the department.
- SECTION 2. Section 45.095 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 45.095 Department designated as child care licensing agency and as family home child care regulatory agency.
 - 1. The department is hereby designated as the child care licensing agency of Washoe County pursuant to subsection 2 of NRS 432A.131.
 - 2. Pursuant to NRS 432A.131(3), the department is hereby designated as the agency of Washoe County which shall register and regulate family home child care.
 - 3. Any person engaged in child care must be registered or licensed as provided by rules and regulations adopted by the department.
- SECTION 3. Section 45.100 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

45.100 Penalties.

1. Any person who provides child care in a center or home without possessing a valid license or registration issued pursuant to rules and regulations adopted by the

department is guilty of a misdemeanor.

2. Any child care facility employee who provides child care for 5 or more children without possessing a valid temporary work permit or work permit authorizing him to do so is guilty of a misdemeanor.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> Sections 25.0840, 25.0841, 25.0842, 25.0843, 25.0844, 25.0845, 25.0846, and 25.0847 are hereby repealed.
