SUMMARY: Amends Washoe County Code by eliminating the Warehouse

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WASHOE COUNTY CODE BY ELIMINATING THE WAREHOUSE FUND; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THEREOF.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 15.080 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

15.080 Intragovernmental service funds: Creation; purposes. Washoe County shall maintain the following intragovernmental service funds:

1. Reproduction fund. This fund is created to effect cost savings and enhance budgetary control over reproduction activities. The reproduction fund will bill each county department for supplies furnished and services rendered. Revenues derived from billings to other county departments are expected to cover the cost of supplies and services rendered plus departmental operating expenses, including, but not limited to, salaries and depreciation. The county comptroller is directed to record a reasonable charge to the reproduction fund for space occupation and utilities for each fiscal year.

2. Central motor vehicle fund. This fund is created to provide accountability for all licensed motor vehicles which were reflected in the fixed asset group of accounts (excluding the sheriff's vehicles) and transferred to the fund. The administrator of the fund is assigned the responsibility for maintaining detailed cost accounting records on each vehicle and establishing billing rates for user departments. Such billing rates to user departments shall be based on time and mileage and calculated to cover all costs and expenses of the central motor vehicle fund, including, but not limited to, salaries, depreciation, fuel and repairs.

3. Heavy equipment fund. This fund provides accountability for all heavy equipment items previously reflected in the fixed asset group of accounts (excluding the sheriff's heavy equipment) and transferred to the fund. The administrator of the fund is assigned the responsibility for maintaining detailed caso accounting records on each heavy equipment item and establishing billing rates for user departments. Such billing rates to user departments shall be based on time and mileage and rates to user departments shall be based on the heavy calculated to cover all costs and expenses of the heavy

equipment fund, including, but not limited to, salaries, depreciation, fuel and repairs.
