Adopts an amended uniform schedule of charges for sewer connection fees within the area of Washoe County for limited portions of the Double Diamond Ranch connecting to the Steamboat Creek Interceptor. Amends sewer rate ordinance No. 830.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE UNIFORM SCHEDULE OF CHARGES FOR SEWER CONNECTION FEES WITHIN THE AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY FOR LIMITED PORTIONS OF THE DOUBLE DIAMOND RANCH CONNECTING TO THE STEAMBOAT CREEK INTERCEPTOR; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO. THIS ORDINANCE AMENDS ORDINANCE NO. 830 (ARTICLE 6).

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

<u>Section 1</u>. Article 6 of Ordinance No. 830 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new Article 6.14 to read as follows:

- 6.14 <u>Connection Charge Payable for Limited Portions of the Double Diamond Ranch Connecting to the Steamboat Creek Interceptor.</u>
 - A. The connection charges set forth in Article 6.1 (A), (B) and (C) shall be reduced 45% (i.e., for payments made prior to January 1, 1996 the single family unit fee would be \$2,392.50, the commercial unit fee would be \$96.25 per each additional fixture unit, etc.), for units within the area designated as Double Diamond Ranch, Steamboat Creek Interceptor Area set forth on Exhibit A. All units within the designated area, Double Diamond Ranch, Steamboat Creek Interceptor Area, shall connect to the Steamboat Creek Interceptor. All other areas of the Double Diamond Ranch shall connect to the Galena Interceptor and pay the connection charges set forth in Article 6.1.
 - B. <u>Connection fee and cash restrictions</u>. All connection fees collected pursuant to Article 6.14 (A) are to be restricted and made available per the connection fee and cash restrictions in Article 6.1 (D).

The utilization and purposes for connection fees and cash restrictions collected pursuant to this Article shall be the same as Article 6.1 (D).
