

Summary - An ordinance amending the ordinance of the County authorizing the issuance of public safety bonds supported by the voters at the November, 1996 general election.

BILL NO. 1170 ORDINANCE NO. 995 (of Washoe County, Nevada)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 972 OF THE COUNTY DESIGNATED AS THE "1996 PUBLIC SAFETY BOND ORDINANCE" IN ORDER TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL PURPOSES FOR WHICH INVESTMENT INCOME EARNED ON BOND PROCEEDS MAY BE EXPENDED; PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION AS IF AN EMERGENCY EXISTS AND PROVIDING OTHER DETAILS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; PROVIDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board" or the "Governing Body") of Washoe County, Nevada (the "County"), pursuant to Ordinance No. 972 of the County adopted and approved on November 16, 1996 (the "Bond Ordinance") has heretofore issued its General Obligation (Limited Tax) Public Safety Bonds, Series December 1, 1996 in the principal amount of \$19,000,000 (the "Bonds") for the purpose of improving and equipping public safety facilities including additions to the inmate housing units at the Consolidated Jail and a regional emergency radio system (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, Section 20 of the Bond Ordinance provides for the use of investment gain received from the investment and reinvestment of the proceeds of the bonds; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to be able to use the investment gain on the bonds in a manner provided by Subsection 4 of 350.658 by allowing that gain to be pledged and deposited into a fund or account pertaining to the Project or its County's general fund, to be used for purposes relating to public safety; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to amend the Ordinance to so provide that investment may be used as provided in the preceding preamble; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined and does hereby determine and declare that this ordinance pertains to the sale, issuance and payment of the bonds; and

WHEREAS, this declaration shall be conclusive in the absence of fraud or gross misdiscretion in accordance with the provisions of Subsection 2 of NRS 350.579; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance may accordingly be adopted as if an emergency now exists and shall take effect from and after its passage and publication twice by title and collateral statement in accordance with law.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

**Section 1.** Section 20 of Ordinance No. 972 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 20. <u>Use of Investment Gain</u>. Pursuant to NRS § 350.658, any gain from any investment and any reinvestment of any proceeds of the Bonds, shall be deposited promptly upon the receipt of such gain at any time or from time to time into the Construction Fund to defray, in part, the cost of the Project or into any fund or account pertaining to the Project or the County's general fund, in any event to be used for the Project and other capital expenditures for the purpose of improving and equipping public safety facilities, or, if adequate provision has been made therefor, into the Principal Fund or the Interest Fund, hereinafter created, for the respective payment of the principal of or interest on the Bonds. As provided in Section 24 hereof ("General Tax Levies"), General Taxes for the payment of the principal of or interest on the Bonds levied after such deposit may be diminished to the extent of the availability of such deposit for the payment of such principal or interest."

**Section 2.** All action heretofore taken by the County and the officers thereof consistent with the provisions of this amendatory ordinance hereby ratified, approved and adopted.

**Section 3.** The officers of the County are authorized to take all action necessary to effectuate the provisions of this Ordinance.

**Section 4.** After its adoption and effective date, copies of this amendatory ordinance shall be transmitted by the County Clerk to Moody's Investors Services and Standard & Poor's Rating Service, as is required by Section 34C of the Bond Ordinance.

Section 5. Publication of Effective Date of Ordinance. The Board has expressed in the preambles to this ordinance that it pertains to the sale, issuance and payment of the Bonds, and accordingly, it shall be adopted as if an emergency exists and final action hereon shall be taken immediately. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after the date of its publication as hereinafter provided, as consent has been received to the amendment made to ordinance No. 972 from the insurer of the Bonds authorized therein, as evidenced by Exhibit I hereto. After this ordinance is signed by the Chairman of the Board and attested and sealed by the County Clerk, this ordinance shall be published twice by title only, together with the names of the Commissioners voting for or against its passage, and with a statement that typewritten copies of said ordinance are available for inspection by all interested parties at the office of the County Clerk, such publications to be made in the Reno Gazette-Journal, a newspaper published and having general circulation in the County, at least once a week for a period of two (2) weeks, such publication to be in substantially the following form:
