**SUMMARY:** Amends existing utility ordinances to provide for the collection of delinquent charges upon the Washoe County general tax roll.

BILL NO. 403

ORDINANCE NO. 1225

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WATER ORDINANCE 1189, SEWER ORDINANCE 1210 AND RECLAIMED WATER ORDINANCE 1190, ARTICLE 7, ENTITLED "TIME AND MANNER OF PAYMENT," TO ADD SUBSECTION 7.5A TO PROVIDE FOR THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT CHARGES ON THE GENERAL COUNTY TAX ROLL.**

THE BOARD OF WASHOE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DOES ORDAIN:

ARTICLE 1. Article 7, entitled "Time And Manner Of Payment," Section 7.5, of Washoe County Ordinances 1189, 1210 and 1190 is hereby amended by adding thereto subsection A so that the same shall read as follows:

7.5 Represents Lien on Property. Until paid, all rates, tolls and charges provided in this Ordinance constitute a perpetual lien on and against the property served and may be foreclosed upon as provided by law.

A. In addition to the foregoing, the Department of Water Resources may cause to have a person's delinquent charges collected on the County's tax roll in the same manner, by the same persons, and at the same time as, together with and not separately from, the County's general taxes as provided by NRS 244.36605. The Department of Water Resources shall have the right to collect from such person(s) four percent (4%) of the amount of the delinquent charges to be collected on the tax roll or an amount estimated by the County Treasurer which is necessary to collect and distribute those delinquent charges, whichever is greater.
