ORDINANCE NO. 1273

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WASHOE COUNTY CODE BY INCREASING FILING FEES TO OFFSET COSTS OF PROVIDING PRO BONO PROGRAMS AND LEGAL SERVICES WITHOUT CHARGE TO ABUSED OR NEGLECTED CHILDREN AND VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 20.710 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 20.710 <u>Justice courts and district court:</u> <u>Imposition of additional filing fee; remittance; use of fees for pro bono programs and programs for abused or neglected children and victims of domestic violence.</u>
- 1. Pursuant to NRS 4.071, there is hereby imposed an additional filing fee of \$10 to be paid on the commencement of any action or proceeding in the justice's court for which a filing fee is required and on the filing of any answer or appearance in any such action or proceeding for which a filing fee is required.
- 2. Pursuant to NRS 19.0312(1)(a), there is hereby imposed an additional filing fee of \$10 to be paid on the commencement of any civil action or proceeding in the district court for which a filing fee is required and on the filing of any answer or appearance in any such action or proceeding for which a filing fee is required.
- 3. On or before the first Monday of each month, the justice(s) of the peace or justice's court administrator(s), and the clerk of the district court shall account for and pay over to the county treasurer any such fees they have collected during the preceding month. The county treasurer shall remit quarterly to the organization referenced in subsection 4 all the money received by him from the justice(s) of the peace or justice's court administrator(s) and the clerk of the district court.
- 4. The fees collected pursuant to this section shall be remitted by the county treasurer to the organization operating

the program for legal services that receives the fees charged pursuant to NRS 19.031 for programs for the indigent. The organization shall use the fees to offset a portion of the costs of providing pro bono programs and providing legal services without charge to abused or neglected children and victims of domestic violence.
