Project Request

Special use permit to allow for a <u>Restricted Market Temporary Aggregate Facility</u> on 16.6+/- acres of land and for excavation of approximately 53,000 CY of material and the export of approximately 45,000 CY of earthen material to the site of the Golden Mesa Phase 1 subdivision (Case Number WTM16-002) which is located to the south of the subject site.

Drainage Improvements will help to minimize current, uncontrolled flood waters that run toward the south and southwest – benefitting residents on Indian and Estates Drives

Minimized Number of Trucks utilizing areas streets to haul needed material to import site (reduces VMT).

Minimizes number of construction trucks needed to go by school zone (public safety)

Distance from export to import site is +/- 700 feet with one crossing of an existing Public roadway (Indian Lane)
