CASE DESCRIPTION

For possible action, hearing, and discussion to approve a tentative parcel map for the Gerlach General Improvement District to allow the subdivision of an 18.96 acre parcel into 4 parcels. One of the parcels will be a large 17.99 acre remainder parcel and the other 3 parcels will meet the minimum lot size for the Medium Density Suburban regulatory zone (i.e. 13,834 sf, 13,394 sf, and 15,201 sf).





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Vicinity Map


Parcel Map

The purpose of a parcel map is to allow for the creation of subdivisions, merger and re-subdivision of existing lots, and common-interest communities consisting of four or fewer parcels pursuant to Washoe County Development Code Article 606, Parcel Maps. A tentative parcel map must be submitted to the Planning and Development Division for the purpose of review prior to or concurrent with the final parcel map. Every tentative parcel map must be prepared by a professional land surveyor. The parcel map process exists to establish reasonable standards of design and procedures for subdividing in order to further the orderly layout and use of land and insure proper legal descriptions and monumenting of subdivided land. Additionally, the process helps to safeguard the public health, safety and general welfare by establishing minimum standards of design and development for any land division platted in the unincorporated area of Washoe County. If the Washoe County Parcel Map Review Committee grants an approval of the tentative parcel map, that approval is subject to Conditions of Approval. Conditions of Approval are requirements that may need to be completed during different stages of the proposed project. Those stages are typically:

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- Prior to recordation of a final map.
- Prior to obtaining a final inspection and/or a certificate of occupancy on a structure.
- Prior to the issuance of a business license or other permits/licenses.
- Some Conditions of Approval are referred to as "Operational Conditions." These conditions must be continually complied with for the life of the project.
- Within 22 months from the date of approval of the tentative parcel map, the applicant must file a final parcel map along with any required supporting materials with the Planning and Development Division and the County Engineer showing that all conditions imposed by the Washoe County Parcel Map Review Committee have been met. Approval or conditional approval of a tentative parcel map imposes no obligation on the part of the Director of Planning and Development Division or the Board of County Commissioners to approve the final parcel map or to accept any public dedication shown on the tentative or final parcel map. Failure to submit a complete final parcel map and pay the required fees within the two year time period shall cease any further action on the map and shall render the tentative parcel map as expired.

The Conditions of Approval for Tentative Parcel Map Case Number WTPM17-0016 are attached to this staff report and will be included with the Action Order, if approved by the Parcel Map Review Committee.

Regulatory Zone: Medium Density Suburban (MDS)

Maximum Lot Potential: 56

Number of Lots on Parcel Map: 4

Minimum Lot Size Required: 12,000 square feet Minimum Lot Size on Parcel Map: 13,834 square feet

Minimum Lot Width Required: 80 feet Minimum Lot Width on Parcel Map: 98 feet

The tentative parcel map meets all minimum requirements for the MDS regulatory zone.

Development Suitability Constraints: The High Desert Area Plan Development Suitability Map, a

part of the High Desert Area Plan, indicates that the parcel is most suitable for development (i.e. slopes less than 15%, no

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wetlands, etc.).

Hydrographic Basin: Black Rock Desert, which is not a designated basin

The subject parcel is outside the Truckee Meadows Service Area (TMSA) in the Rural Development Area (RDA).

High Desert Area Plan Modifiers

There are no High Desert Area Plan Modifiers applicable to this tentative parcel map application.

Utilities and Access

The tentative parcel map would create three new parcels and one large remainder parcel. Water and sewer for the new parcels will be provided by the Gerlach General Improvement District. Access is readily available off of Diablo Drive and adequate utility easements have been provided.

Development Information

The property is currently vacant and undeveloped. The intended use of the newly created parcels is for residential development.

Staff Comment on Required Findings

Washoe County Code Section 110.606.30 (i) requires that all of the following findings be made to the satisfaction of the Washoe County Parcel Map Review Committee before granting approval of the request. Staff has completed an analysis of the application and has determined that the proposal is in compliance with the required findings as follows.

- 1) General improvement considerations for all parcel maps including, but not limited to:
 - a) Environmental and health laws and regulations concerning water and air pollution, the disposal of solid waste, facilities to supply water, community or public sewage disposal and, where applicable, individual systems for sewage disposal.
 - <u>Staff Comment</u>: The proposed map has been reviewed by the Health District and appropriate conditions of approval have been provided.
 - b) The availability of water which meets applicable health standards and is sufficient for the reasonably foreseeable needs of the subdivision.
 - <u>Staff Comment</u>: The resultant parcels will be served by the Gerlach General Improvement District, a licensed public water system in the State of Nevada.
 - c) The availability and accessibility of utilities.
 - <u>Staff Comment</u>: Adequate utility infrastructure is available to the site as the subject property is surrounded by existing development.
 - d) The availability and accessibility of public services such as schools, police and fire protection, transportation, recreation and parks.
 - <u>Staff Comment</u>: The application was reviewed by all interested agencies and appropriate conditions of approval from those agencies have been included with the recommendation. Adequate capacity exists in the Gerlach school system.
 - e) Conformity with the zoning ordinances and master plan.
 - <u>Staff Comment</u>. Lot size and residential density of the proposed map is in conformance with the zoning and master plan.
 - f) General conformity with the governing body's master plan of streets and highways.
 - <u>Staff Comment</u>: The proposed development will be served by existing paved public roadways.
 - g) The effect of the proposed subdivision on existing public streets and the need for new streets or highways to serve the subdivision.

- <u>Staff Comment</u>: The proposed development will be served by existing paved public roadways. Adequate road capacity exists to maintain the adopted Level of Service.
- h) Physical characteristics of the land such as floodplain, slope and soil.
 - <u>Staff Comment</u>: The subject property is not constrained by the physical characteristics of the land. There are no floodplain, slope, or soil constraints. Each of the proposed parcels appears to contain suitable areas for building pads.
- i) The recommendations and comments of those entities reviewing the tentative parcel map pursuant to NRS 278.330 and 278.348, inclusive.
 - <u>Staff Comment</u>: These provisions of statute refer to the preparation and distribution of tentative maps. All recommended conditions of approval from reviewing agencies have been included with the staff report.
- j) The availability and accessibility of fire protection including, but not limited to, the availability and accessibility of water and services for the prevention and containment of fires including fires in wild lands.
 - <u>Staff Comment</u>: The subject property is surrounded by existing development and adequate fire protection is available.
- k) Community antenna television (CATV) conduit and pull wire.
 - <u>Staff Comment</u>: Utility easements will be provided to service all lots.
- I) Recreation and trail easements.
 - <u>Staff Comment</u>: Recreation and trail easements are not proposed to be established as part of the proposed map and no trails will be impacted by the subdivision.
- 2) Subdivision improvement considerations for second or subsequent parcel maps pursuant to Section 110.606.30(d) and which are in addition to the criteria listed above.
 - <u>Staff Comment</u>: The tentative map is not a second or subsequent parcel map pursuant to Section 110.606.30(d).

Recommendation

Those agencies which reviewed the application recommended conditions in support of approval of the tentative parcel map or provided no comment. Therefore, after a thorough analysis and review, Parcel Map Case Number WTPM17-0016 is being recommended for approval with conditions. Staff offers the following motion for the Parcel Map Review Committee's consideration.

Motion / Review Criteria

I move that, after giving reasoned consideration to the information contained within the staff report and the information received during the public meeting, that the Washoe County Parcel Map Review Committee approve Tentative Parcel Map Case Number WTPM17-0016 (Gerlach GID), subject to the conditions of approval as listed in Exhibit A of the staff report, and make the determination that the following criteria is or will be adequately provided for pursuant to Washoe County Code Section 110.606.30:

- 1) General improvement considerations for all parcel maps including, but not limited to:
 - a) Environmental and health laws and regulations concerning water and air pollution, the disposal of solid waste, facilities to supply water, community or public sewage disposal and, where applicable, individual systems for sewage disposal;
 - b) The availability of water which meets applicable health standards and is sufficient for the reasonably foreseeable needs of the subdivision;
 - c) The availability and accessibility of utilities;

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- d) The availability and accessibility of public services such as schools, police and fire protection, transportation, recreation and parks;
- e) Conformity with the zoning ordinances and master plan;
- f) General conformity with the governing body's master plan of streets and highways;
- g) The effect of the proposed subdivision on existing public streets and the need for new streets or highways to serve the subdivision;
- h) Physical characteristics of the land such as floodplain, slope and soil;
- i) The recommendations and comments of those entities reviewing the tentative parcel map pursuant to NRS 278.330 and 278.348, inclusive;
- j) The availability and accessibility of fire protection including, but not limited to, the availability and accessibility of water and services for the prevention and containment of fires including fires in wild lands;
- k) Community antenna television (CATV) conduit and pull wire; and
- I) Recreation and trail easements.
- 2) Subdivision improvement considerations for second or subsequent parcel maps pursuant to Section 110.606.30(d) and which are in addition to the criteria listed above.

Appeal Process

Parcel Map Review Committee action will be effective 10 calendar days after the written decision is filed with the Secretary to the Parcel Map Review Committee, unless the action is appealed to the Washoe County Board of County Commissioners, in which case the outcome of the appeal shall be determined by the Board of County Commissioners. Any appeal must be filed in writing within 10 calendar days after the written decision is filed with and signed by the Secretary of the Parcel Map Review Committee and mailed to the applicant.

Conditions of Approval

Tentative Parcel Map Case Number WTPM17-0016

The tentative parcel map approved under Tentative Parcel Map Case Number WTPM17-0016 shall be carried out in accordance with the Conditions of Approval granted by the Washoe County Parcel Map Review Committee on November 9, 2017. Conditions of Approval are requirements placed on a permit or development by each reviewing agency. These Conditions of Approval may require submittal of documents, applications, fees, inspections, amendments to plans, and more. These conditions do not relieve the applicant of the obligation to obtain any other approvals and licenses from relevant authorities required under any other act or to abide by all other generally applicable Codes, and neither these conditions nor the approval by the County of this project/use override or negate any other applicable restrictions on uses or development on the property.

<u>Unless otherwise specified</u>, all conditions related to the approval of this tentative parcel map shall be met or financial assurance must be provided to satisfy the conditions of approval prior to the recordation of a final parcel map. The agency responsible for determining compliance with a specific condition shall determine whether the condition must be fully completed or whether the applicant shall be offered the option of providing financial assurance. All agreements, easements, or other documentation required by these conditions shall have a copy filed with the County Engineer and the Planning and Building Division.

Compliance with the conditions of approval related to this tentative parcel map is the responsibility of the applicant, his/her successor in interest, and all owners, assignees, and occupants of the property and their successors in interest. Failure to comply with any of the conditions imposed in the approval of the tentative parcel map may result in the institution of revocation procedures.

Washoe County reserves the right to review and revise the Conditions of Approval related to this tentative parcel map should it be determined that a subsequent license or permit issued by Washoe County violates the intent of this approval.

For the purpose of conditions imposed by Washoe County, "may" is permissive and "shall" or "must" is mandatory.

Conditions of Approval are usually complied with at different stages of the proposed project. Those stages are typically:

- Prior to recordation of a final map.
- Prior to obtaining a final inspection and/or a certificate of occupancy.
- Prior to the issuance of a business license or other permits/licenses.
- Some "Conditions of Approval" are referred to as "Operational Conditions." These conditions must be continually complied with for the life of the project.

FOLLOWING ARE CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL REQUIRED BY THE REVIEWING AGENCIES. EACH CONDITION MUST BE MET TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE ISSUING AGENCY.

The final map shall be in substantial compliance with all plans and documents submitted as part of this tentative parcel map application, and with any amendments imposed by the Parcel Map Review Committee. All documentation necessary to satisfy the conditions noted below shall accompany the final map when submitted to the County Engineer and the Planning and Building Division.
- b. The applicant shall comply with all the conditions of approval and shall submit a final map for signature by the Director of the Planning and Building Division within 22 months from the date of approval by the Parcel Map Review Committee. Each agency responsible for imposing conditions may determine whether its conditions must be fully completed or whether the applicant shall be offered the option of providing financial assurances as a means of assuring compliance.
- c. The final map shall contain the following jurat:

- d. Any regulations, procedures, and conditions adopted by the Washoe County Health District must be met prior to recordation of a final map.
- e. The applicant has indicated that the proposed improvements will not exceed the major grading thresholds that require a special use permit. If the final construction drawings for the map include grading that exceeds the *Major Grading Permit Thresholds* listed in Article 438 Grading Standards, the applicant shall apply for a special use permit for grading; and if approved, may be delayed up to three months processing time. In addition, all related standards within the Washoe County Building Code shall be met on the construction drawings. Compliance shall be determined by the Planning and Building Division.

- f. The approval for this tentative parcel map does not include improvements for driveways to building pads. Grading for access to building pads, if they exceed the criteria stated in the previous condition, shall require a special use permit. Compliance shall be determined by the Planning and Building Division.
- 2. The following conditions are requirements of the Planning and Building Division, Water Management Planner Coordinator, which shall be responsible for determining compliance with these conditions.




