<u>Possible Changes to Agenda and Timing</u>. Items on this agenda may be taken out of order, combined with other items, removed from the agenda or moved to the agenda of a later meeting. Items on this agenda may also be moved to or from the consent section. Items designated for a specified time will not be heard prior to the stated time but may be heard later.

Public Comment. Public comments are welcomed during the public comment periods at the beginning and end of the meeting and during public hearing and project review items and are limited to three (3) minutes per person. Persons may not allocate unused time to other speakers.

Members of the public may submit public comment via Zoom or by dialing into the meeting by telephone. To provide public comment via Zoom, log into the ZOOM webinar at the above link and utilize the "Raise Hand" feature during any public comment period. To provide public comment via telephone only, press *9 to "Raise Hand" and *6 to mute/unmute.

Additionally, public comment can be submitted via email to <u>washoe311@washoecounty.gov</u>. The County will make reasonable efforts to send all email comments received by 4:00 p.m. on January 11, 2023, to the Committee members prior to the meeting.

During the general public comment periods at the beginning and end of the meeting, speakers may address any matter either on or off the agenda, including items heard on the consent section of the agenda. For the remainder of the agenda, public comment will only be heard during public hearing and project review items and should be

about the specific item being considered by the Committee at that time. If an item is continued, then public comment will not be heard for that item until the date of the continued hearing.

Presentations and public comment for individual agenda items are limited as follows: fifteen minutes each for staff and applicant presentations and three minutes for individual speakers unless extended by questions from the Committee or by action of the Chair. All comments are to be directed to the Committee as a whole and not to one individual. Emails will be included in the record but will only be read aloud during the meeting subject to the chair's discretion and if time permits.

Responses to Public Comments. The Parcel Map Review Committee may deliberate or take action only if a matter has been listed on an agenda properly posted prior to the meeting. The Open Meeting Law does not expressly prohibit responses to public comments by the Committee. However, responses from Committee members to unlisted public comment topics could become deliberation on a matter without notice to the public. To avoid this situation and to ensure that the public has notice of all matters the Committee will consider, members may choose not to respond to public comments, except to correct factual inaccuracies, ask for County staff action, or to ask that a matter be listed on a future agenda.

Forum Restrictions and Orderly Conduct of Business. The Parcel Map Review Committee conducts the business of Washoe County and its citizens during its meetings. The presiding officer may order the removal of any person whose statement or other conduct disrupts the orderly, efficient or safe conduct of the meeting. Warnings against disruptive comments or behavior may or may not be given prior to removal. The viewpoint of a speaker will not be restricted, but reasonable restrictions may be imposed upon the time, place and manner of speech. Irrelevant and unduly repetitious statements and personal attacks which antagonize or incite others are examples of speech that may be reasonably limited.

<u>Appeal Procedure</u>. Most decisions rendered by the Parcel Map Review Committee are appealable. If you disagree with the decision of the Parcel Map Review Committee and you want to appeal its action, call the Planning staff immediately, at (775) 328-6100. You will be informed of the appeal procedure and application fee. Appeals must be in writing and must be delivered to the Planning and Building Division within 10 calendar days from the date that the decision being appealed is signed by the Secretary of the Parcel Map Review Committee and mailed to the original applicant in the proceeding being appealed, in accordance with Washoe County Code.

An appeal of the Parcel Map Review Committee's decision on a <u>Tentative Parcel Map</u> may be made to the Board of County Commissioners in accordance with Section 110.912.20 of the Development Code.

An appeal of the Committee's decision on a <u>Final Parcel Map</u> may be made to the Board of Adjustment in accordance with Section 110.912.10 of the Development Code.

A. <u>Amendment of Conditions Case Number WAC22-0011 for Tentative Parcel Map Case</u> <u>Number WTPM21-0022 (BDF Trust)</u> [For possible action] – For hearing, discussion, and possible action to amend approved Tentative Parcel Map WTPM21-0022, which was finalized and recorded on April 22, 2021, to correct an error in the boundary line along the west side of Parcel 1, being the easterly right-of-way (ROW) of Lemmon Drive. This adjustment reduces the size of Parcel 1 by ±15,149 SF which is included in Lemon Drive ROW. Also, to re-configure the property line between the two parcels. The acreage will change for Parcel 1 from ±18.57 acres to ±18.09 acres and Parcel 2 from ±13.85 acres to ±14.33 acres.
