Applicant supplied information for the Street Naming Committee

Regarding: Renaming of the section of N. Center Street to "University Way", from the Truckee River to the gates of the University of Nevada, Reno.

History:

- At its November 16, 1920 meeting, the Board of Regents, Reno Mayor and City Council changed 'Center Street' to be renamed to 'University Avenue.'
- In 1957, the City extended the name 'University Avenue' all the way south to Virginia Street, dropping the name 'Center Street' altogether. Later the City renamed the entire length back to 'Center Street,' ending the term of 'University Avenue.' Newspaper accounts attribute the loss of support for a full-length 'University Avenue' to unintended impacts on the addresses of residents and business on what had been South Center Street.

There are currently strong ties established between the University of Nevada, Reno and the City of Reno. The renaming of this street will strengthen those ties, giving the University a more concrete presence in downtown Reno and enhancing the City of Reno's image of being a University Town.

A key discussion has been conflict in Address: Example: The word University within current named streets with same street number associated, example: 400 University Terrace and 400 University Way). See Exhibit "A" for additional information.

- o The University only found three conflict with the same number within all "University" named streets:
 - N. Center Street has three conflicting addresses with University Terrace, from the River to the University. No others streets have conflicts in address numbers. Those addresses on N. Center Street are 150 (Cal Neva Parking) 400 (Reno Event Center) and 401 (Reno Ballroom) which are all commercial properties.
 - The three properties on University Terrace that have conflict, 150, 400 & 401 which are all residential properties and have a different zip code.

There are 12 owners and 18 parcels impacted by the request for University Way. Of these 18 parcels, 7 are owned by the City of Reno. Discussions with private owners the University was able to reach indicate support for University Way, none in opposition. We have the following Letters of Support from owners/representatives of property on Center Street supporting this requested change:
