- 5. BASEMAP COMMITTEE FUND UPDATE** [Non-Action Item] – An informational update on the status of the Basemap Committee fund. Quinn Korbolic – Washoe County Technology Services.

Quinn Korbolic reviewed the current fund balance, Data Sales data, and expected revenue/expenses. The FY24/25 Year-to-date balance is \$213,379.84, with Data Sales at \$9360 and Subscription/Membership at \$72,000. There will be an upcoming payment of approximately \$43,000 for the Sanborn mapping project, which would be deducted from the current fiscal year's fund balance.

- 6. AERIAL IMAGERY ACQUISITION UPDATE** [Non-Action Item] – An informational update on the status of Request for Proposal (RFP) 3263-24 seeking a vendor to provide updated digital orthophotography and elevation data products. Gary Zaepfel – Washoe County Technology Services.

Member Zaepfel reported that Sanborn had been flying in the area for the past month and a half, with the last date of data acquisition being May 24th. The raw data looked good, with minimal snow visible in higher elevations. The raw data had not yet been processed or color balanced but appeared satisfactory. He expected initial products to be delivered by September. He further confirmed that the contract with Sanborn had been finalized and approved by the Board of County Commissioners. Sanborn would be providing 6-inch ortho photography and 26 sections of contour data.

Member Zaepfel also reported that finalizing the Eagle View contract had taken longer than expected due to extensive negotiations over the insurance and service agreements. Both sides were now satisfied with the terms. The contract is set to be approved by the Board of County Commissioners on July 8th. This delay means the preferred acquisition window has been missed. He discussed two options for the timing of the first flight: waiting until the fall when vegetation is less dense or postponing until the spring of the next year to ensure early acquisition. He further clarified that no payments would be made to Eagle View until the contract was finalized.

- 7. REGIONALLY SIGNIFICANT DATA** [For Possible Action] – A review, discussion, and possible action to designate specific geospatial data including, but not limited to, tax assessor parcels and E911 addresses as regionally significant. Discussion topics may include, but are not limited to, categorizing additional geospatial data that may be considered regionally significant, delineating data maintenance responsibilities, public access availability, and data distribution channels. Member Friedlander mentioned that the Hexagon project for the new CAD system for dispatch has been pushed back to December. There was no response to the call for public comment.
