

# Dust Control Permit Sign Requirements

The owner and/or operator shall erect an informational sign near the main entrance to the project site where it can be easily observed by the public and the AQMD. The sign shall be installed prior to breaking ground and shall remain in place for the duration of the project. The sign shall have a minimum dimension of 4 feet by 4 feet and sign lettering shall be in a contrasting color to the background (see example below for alpha and numeric text dimension requirements). The sign shall be constructed with materials capable of withstanding wind and harsh environments.

The sign shall have the following information:

- a) Project Name
- b) Permittee Name
- c) Dust Control Permit Number
- d) Project Acreage
- e) Expiration Date
- f) Phone Number of Person Responsible for Dust Control Matters
- g) Washoe County AQMD Phone Number
