The Washoe County Health District – Air Quality Management Division (AQMD) is proposing to make significant revisions to the regulations governing wood-burning devices. The changes affect all wood-burning devices including wood heaters, fireplaces, and hydronic heaters. In addition, the proposed changes have the potential to impact all escrow transactions and the sale of all wood-burning devices in Washoe County.

The AQMD will hold a Public Workshop aimed at accepting public comment about the proposed changes to the District Board of Health Regulations Governing Air Quality Management Section 040.051 Wood-Burning Devices before they take effect in July 2022.
