At times, accomplishing one's housing goals means a participant may start to address other barriers that are difficult to manage in a shelter. For example, some participants who arrive on Campus have survived other forms of life altering events that have led one to experience homelessness.

This story is about one of our participants who was experiencing homelessness for the last couple of years, after having survived domestic violence. In addition to this, the participant struggled with alcohol abuse and health conditions that as mentioned, are difficult to manage in a shelter.

With the assistance of her case manager and Shelter Plus Care housing assistance, she was able to obtain permanent housing. The participant was sincerely happy and thankful to have her own place to call home again. Her Case Manager believes the participant will thrive in a healthier living environment, as she has great potential to overcome medical and mental health obstacles.
