SECTION 34 LICENSING ENTITY ADMINISTRATION

- 34.1 <u>Investigations/inspections</u>. In exercising the powers of approving, denying, revoking, suspending, or limiting licenses or making provisional licenses, the Agency shall investigate and inspect licensees and approved operators and applicants for a license of a facility. Any authorized member or employee of the Agency may enter and inspect any building or premises of a facility at any time to secure compliance with or prevent a violation of any provision of these Regulations.
- *34.2 <u>Bureau of Child Care Licensing</u>. The Agency shall submit quarterly reports of new licenses, license renewals, and license terminations to the Nevada Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public and Behavioral Health as required by NRS 432A.180.2 of the Regulations and Standards for Child Care Facilities.
- 34.3 <u>Information available to public</u>. Information relating to the licensing process and administration of Washoe County Code Chapter 45 shall be maintained by the Agency and shall be freely available to the general public.
- 34.4 <u>Assistance and consultation</u>. Child care licensing inspectors shall offer assistance, support and consultation as a regular part of their duties.
