Waiver of Regulations

SECTION 36 WAIVER OF REGULATIONS

- 36.1 <u>Application</u>. A person who desires a waiver of all or any part of Regulations concerning licensing must submit a completed application for the waiver to the Agency's child care licensing supervisor.
- *36.2 <u>Review of Application</u>. The Agency's child care licensing supervisor will review the application for the waiver and will act upon the application within 30 days from the date it is received in the Agency.
- 36.3 <u>Criteria</u>. The Agency Director may grant a waiver of a Washoe County Regulation if he determines that good cause exists. The Agency Director must not grant a waiver which will threaten public health or safety.
- 36.4 <u>Period of waiver</u>. The Agency Director will specify the length of time a waiver is in effect.
- 36.5 <u>Revocation</u>. A waiver granted by the Agency Director will be revoked before the expiration of the period of the waiver if the Agency Director determines that public health or safety is threatened or if the basis upon which the waiver was granted no longer exists.
- 36.6 <u>Good cause</u>. For the purposes of this Section, "good cause" exists where an applicant is unduly burdened by a regulation and thereby suffers a severe hardship because of circumstances or conditions which are unique to him.
