What is the Washoe County Incline Village Community Center?

The Incline Village Community Center is a centralized hub for socialization and access to resources in Incline Village, Nevada.

Where is the Washoe County Incline Village Community Center?

Located next to the Incline Village Library at 855 Alder Avenue, the center has two rooms that are available to seniors for drop in activities, a conference room that can be reserved and a larger activity room for community use.

Who can use the center?

- Drop in activities and use of the larger activity rooms are targeted for the senior population in Incline Village and Crystal Bay.
- Group coordinators and residents may also use the conference room by reservation to host community meetings.
- In addition, the center is accessible to the entire community to access local government and non-profits including Tahoe Regional Planning Agency, Tahoe Transportation District and United States Forest Service. These organizations all offer local community resources at the facility.

What are the current hours?

Drop-in hours are Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 1 p.m. – 4 p.m. Conference rooms are open Mon-Fri from 10 a.m. – 6 p.m., by reservation only.
