**In Person and Online Viewing.** Effective September 8, 2020, the public will be allowed in the Washoe County Human Resources Training Room, not to exceed 50% of capacity at any given time. Due to evolving concerns for public safety resulting from the COVID-19 emergency and pursuant to the Governor of Nevada’s Declaration of Emergency Directive 006 Section 1 (extended by later Directives the most recent of which is Directive 029), which suspends the requirement in NRS 241.023(1)(b) that there be a physical location designated for meetings of public bodies where members of the public are permitted to attend and participate, future meetings may be held by teleconference only. Any member of the public wanting to attend, participate or provide public comment in-person at meetings should review the Committee’s agenda posted online at [https://www.washoecounty.us/humanresources/board\\_committees/deferred\\_compensation/index.php](https://www.washoecounty.us/humanresources/board_committees/deferred_compensation/index.php) to determine whether in-person attendance has been suspended by the Governor or Board of County Commissioners.

Public comments for all matters, whether listed on the agenda or not, are welcomed during the “Public comment,” and are limited to two minutes per person. Persons may not allocate unused time to other speakers. **As required by the Governor’s Declaration of Emergency Directive 006 Section 2, members of the public may submit public comment by teleconference by logging into the ZOOM webinar by accessing the following link: <https://us02web.zoom.us/j/82744762544>.** NOTE: This option will require a computer with audio and video capabilities. Additionally, **public comment can be submitted via email to [aberrington@washoecounty.us](mailto:aberrington@washoecounty.us).** The Committee will make reasonable efforts to include all comments received for public comment by email in the record. Please try to provide comments by 4:00 p.m. on November 10, 2020. The presiding officer may order the removal of any person whose statement or other conduct disrupts the orderly, efficient or safe conduct of the meeting. Warnings against disruptive conduct may or may not be given before removal. The viewpoint of a speaker will not be restricted, but reasonable restrictions may be imposed upon the time, place and manner of speech. Irrelevant and unduly repetitious statements and personal attacks which antagonize or incite others are examples of speech that may be reasonably limited.
