# Available Assistance

## What our Programs Offer:

- Rental Assistance
- Deposit Assistance
- Application Fee Assistance (limit 1)
- Utility Assistance (Water, Power, and Gas)



## Funding:

- Emergency Solutions Grant
  - Up to 30% AMI
  - 3 months of assistance
  - Units cannot exceed 100% FMR
- Affordable Housing Trust Fund
  - Up to 60% AMI
  - 3 months of assistance
  - Units cannot exceed 100% FMR
- Emergency Rental Assistance Program
  - Up to 80% AMI
  - Up to 15 months of assistance
  - Must have an impact due to the pandemic

## What our Programs Do Not Offer:

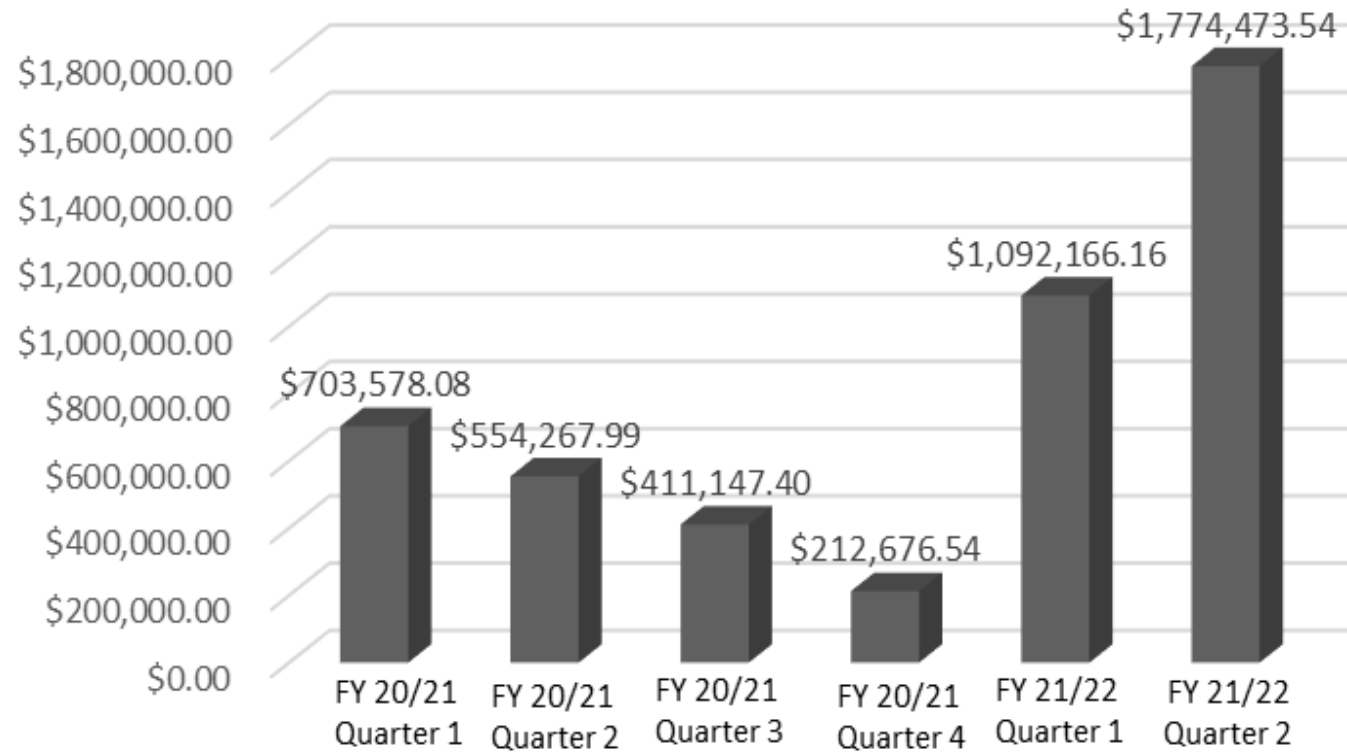
- Motel/Hotel Assistance

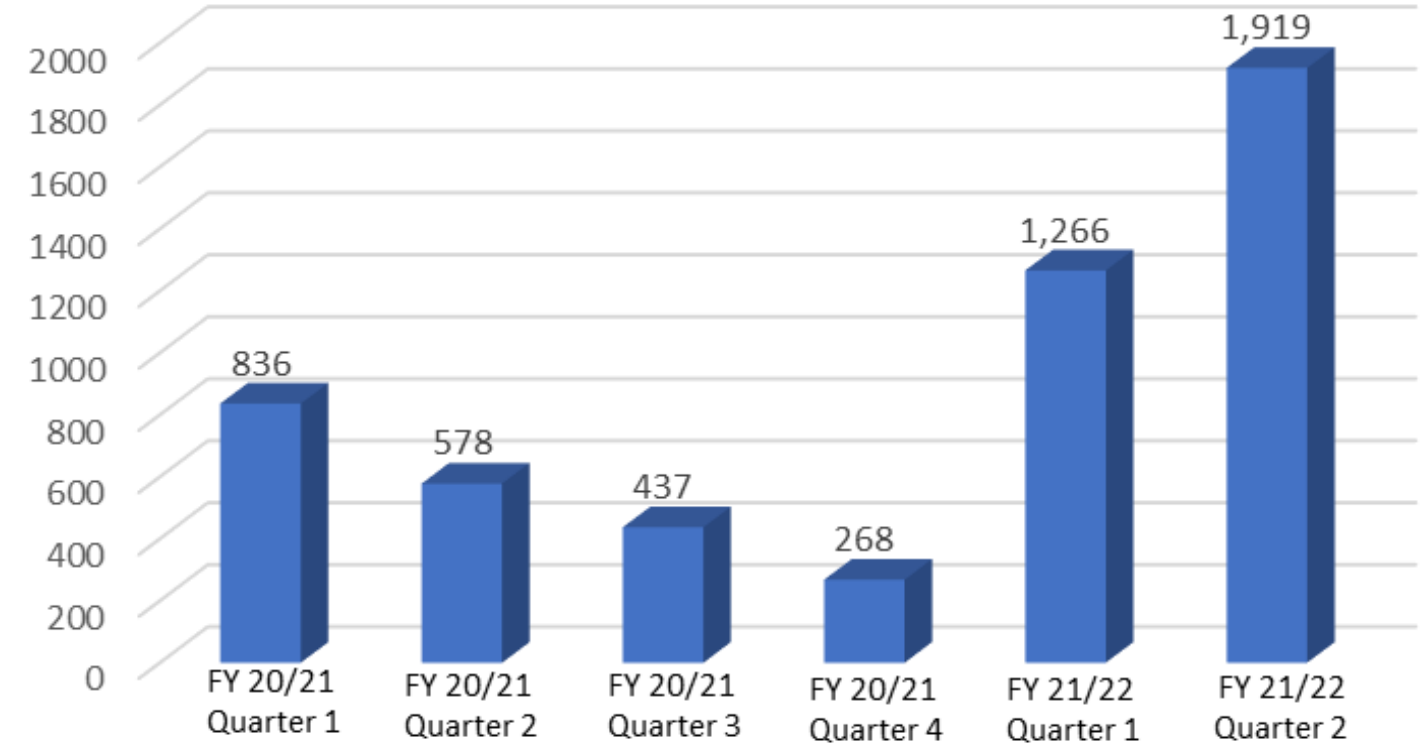

Amount of Funds Disbursed by Quarter Since July 1, 2020



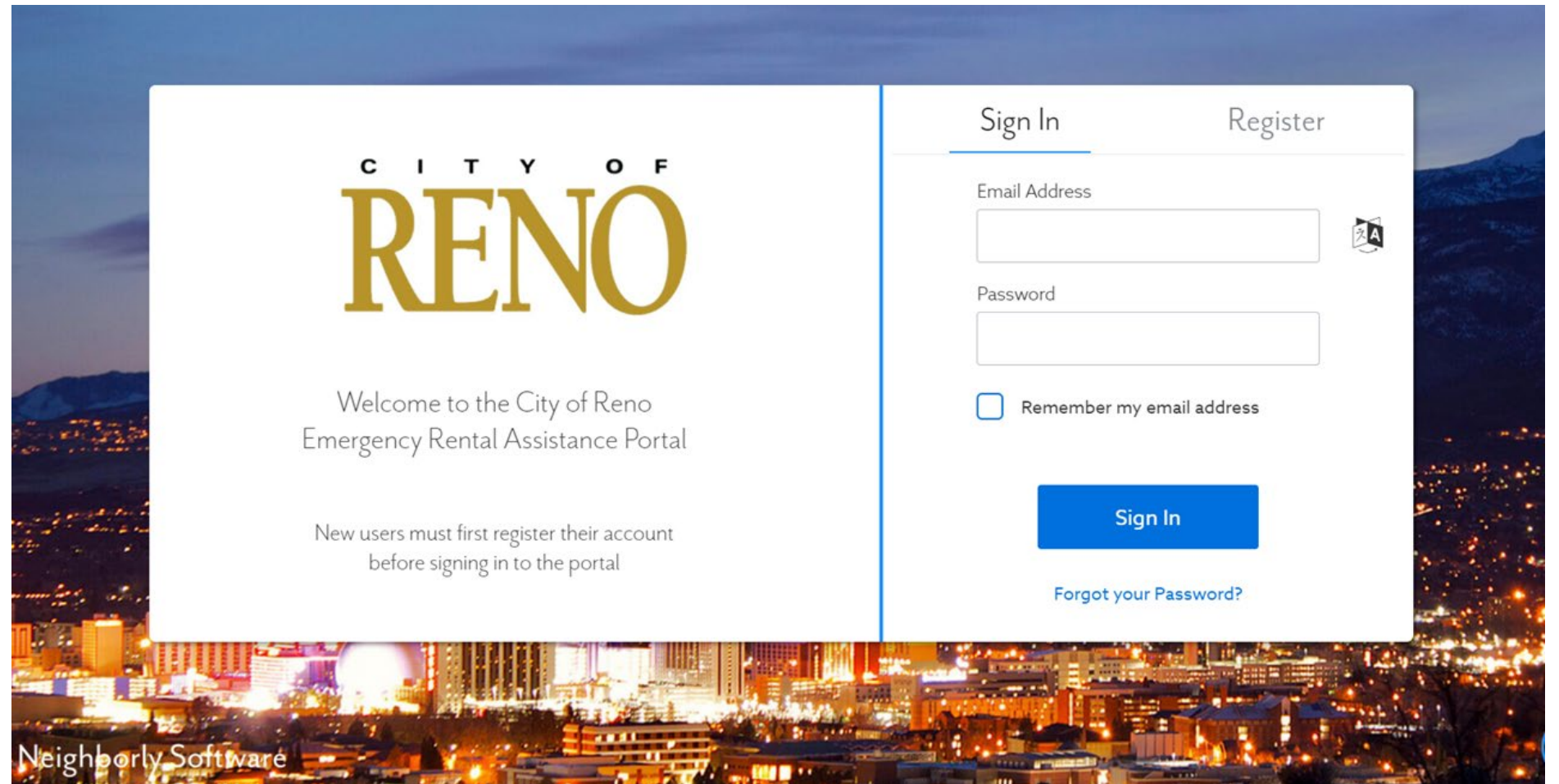
Months of Assistance Provided by Quarter Since July 1, 2020
