- Community Dashboard Monthly reporting and analysis.
- A detailed inventory and gap analysis of our housing capacity enables us to add beds where needed and use limited resources in an effective way.

➤ **Outreach Coverage & Coordination:**

- Coordinate outreach between groups to maximize efficiency & decrease duplicative efforts.

➤ **Case Conferencing**

- Management of the By-Name list through case conferencing with the focus of finding housing for people.






People Experiencing Homelessness in Washoe County - By Gender April 2022




People Experiencing Homelessness in Washoe County (By-Name List)




