Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES)

- Grant Award by the US Treasury intended to reimburse local governments for costs in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and public health emergency
- Total of \$150 Billion authorized nationally
- State of Nevada \$1.25 Billion
- Regional Allocation \$86.1 Million:


Washoe County	\$20,254,818

City of Sparks	\$19,176,261



CRF-CARES – First Allocation (50%)

First Allocation (50%) is to reimburse costs incurred March-June, and costs planned July-August

Regional Expenses:

March - June, 2020 Actual	2,392,634
July - August, 2020 Planned	3,567,344
Total Regional	\$ 5,959,978

Internal Expenses:

March - June, 2020 Actual	\$1,781,301
July - August, 2020 Planned	\$2,386,129
Total Internal	\$4,167,430

Total Expenditures	\$ 10,127,409
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CRF-CARES – ELIGIBLE USES

- Costs incurred during the period March 1 - December 30, 2020
- Necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency
- Costs that were not budgeted -
 - Cost cannot lawfully be funded within an existing budget
 - Cost is for a substantially different use from any expected use in the budget
 - A cost is not considered to have been budgeted merely because it could be funded using a budgetary stabilization fund or other reserve account



CRF-CARES – ELIGIBLE COSTS

COVID-19 Related Expenses: Categories for Reporting

- ✓ To address medical needs
- ✓ To address public health needs
- ✓ Personal Protective Equipment: worn to minimize the exposure to hazards
- ✓ Testing and Contact Tracing
- ✓ Payroll expenses for public employees
 - whose services are **substantially dedicated** to mitigating or responding to the COVID-19 public health emergency



CRF-CARES – ELIGIBLE COSTS

COVID-19 Related Expenses:

- ✓ To facilitate compliance with COVID-19 related public health measures
 - Improving Teleworking
 - Improving Social Distancing
 - COVID related Jail expenses
 - Nursing Home Assistance
- ✓ For economic support in connection with the COVID-19 public health emergency
 - Small Business Assistance
 - Care & Mitigation for homeless/vulnerable populations
 - Prevent evictions
 - Food Programs
- ✓ To respond to secondary effects of the current COVID-19 public health emergency
- ✓ Other costs reasonably necessary government functions and satisfy the eligibility criteria



CRF-CARES – APPROVED EXPENSES

- Procurement Standards – Federal UG, NRS, WC Policy
- Federal
 - Micro \$10,000 or below
 - Small Purchase \$10,001 - \$100,000
 - Competitive Proposal- Advertised Bids Over \$100K
 - Sole Source/ Noncompetitive proposals
 - Over \$10,000 requiring single source proposals
