



Washoe County has been working with the Reno Tennis Club since 2007.

The agreement allows for Reno Tennis Club to have some exclusive use of the courts in exchange for the operation and maintenance of the courts.

The Reno Tennis Club members are at the courts on a daily basis.



Washoe Tennis Center

- The agreement requires that \$3000 annually are put back into the maintenance of the area.
- RTC often puts 4-5x that amount in annually. Resurfacing of 2 courts can cost approximately \$12,000 and they typically resurface two courts each year, on a 3-year cycle.
- Washoe County utilizes the Parks Infrastructure Preservation Fund to assist with on-going maintenance needs.
- The next several slides are examples of some of the improvement projects that have been completed over the past 5 years.
