Open Space and Regional Park Commission Meeting
December 7, 2021

SOUTH REGION HIGHLIGHTS

- Revenue for facility rentals has increased at all facilities due to the loosening of Covid restrictions in our facilities.
- Restrooms at some of the parks have been winterized and will be closed for the winter.
- Hidden Valley Regional Park hosted a 10k, and 5k race on November 13th with approximately 200 participants.
- X-mas trees for families were cut at Galena Creek on November 30th, and will be distributed to families on December 2nd.

- Free X-mas trees for families will be distributed on December 2nd.
- Bartley Ranch will be one of the sites for KTMB's X-mas tree recycling program.
