




Brown's Creek Trail Re-alignment Proposal






Existing Trail

Parcel Ownership





Background



- Washoe County Parks' goals:
 - Maintain public access through the parcel.
 - Ensure that any re-alignment would be sustainably designed and developed.
 - Maintain or enhance the user experience.



Current Proposal



- Provide views of Washoe Valley
- Built to modern sustainability standards
- Decommission the existing trail
- Purchase a new trailhead map and additional signage
- Grant Washoe County a public trail easement over new trail alignment



Construction Impacts

- Approximately 2 weeks to complete the work
- Build re-route first and then decommission existing trail
- Install temporary signage
- Reseed the decommissioned area, as necessary
