Open Space and Regional Park Commission Meeting  
February 1, 2022

## **SOUTH REGION HIGHLIGHTS**

- KTMB's X-mas tree recycling program at Bartley Ranch was very busy. Approximately 4000 trees were brought into the park and mulched for use by the public and in Washoe County Parks.
- Come in From the Cold programming at Bartley Ranch began on January 8th and will continue Saturday evenings at 7pm through March 12<sup>th</sup>.
- Bartley Ranch Regional Park and South Valleys Regional Park are Covid testing locations. The demand for testing was overwhelming at both locations and did present some traffic challenges.

## **UPCOMING EVENTS**

- The Come in From the Cold series at Bartley Ranch Regional Park will continue through March 12. The performances start at 7pm each Saturday.
- TMFPD will continue to help eliminating some of the hazard trees located at Davis Creek Regional Park and Bowers Mansion.

## **NORTH REGION HIGHLIGHTS**

- KTMB's X-mas tree recycling program at Rancho San Rafael was very busy. Over 10,000 trees were brought into the parks and mulched for use by the public and in Washoe County Parks.
- North Valleys Regional Park and Eagle Canyon Park are Covid testing locations. Both sites have been extremely busy and have had traffic impacts on the surrounding areas and have run out of the daily allotment of tests on a regular basis.
