

# Open Space and Regional Parks Commission Meeting November 2024

## **SOUTH REGION HIGHLIGHTS**

- Truckee River Cleanup was on September 21<sup>st</sup> with over 20 sites including Lockwood Park among others\_with a BBQ that followed at Bartley Ranch Regional Park
- The Nevada Youth Employment Fall Festival was hosted at Bartley Ranch Regional Park on September 22<sup>nd</sup>. Bartley Ranch had over 300 kids enjoying fall activities including carnival games, and a petting zoo.
- Junior Ranger Adventure Day will be held at Bowers Mansion Regional Park on September 28<sup>th</sup> from 1pm-2pm. Kids were treated to a tour of the Historic Bowers Mansion and a guided hike to explore the various ecosystems surrounding Bowers Mansion Park
- Bowers Mansion Living History Day was held on October 19<sup>th</sup> from 11am-3pm. There
  were lots of stories shared and over 130 people got to experience the self-guided
  tours and historic activities in the park.
