- Reno needed an event just for us locals
- Reno needed an opportunity for entrepreneurs in the mobile food industry to grow and thrive
- I wanted a place for families and friends to gather and be together.
- I wanted to create a culinary experience for Reno, much like an Anthony Bourdain show about street food or a San Luis Obispo, CA Farmers market.
- Food Truck Friday at Idlewild Park has been our community solution.
- New this year we are adding Wednesday in South Reno and Thursday in North Valleys.










# North Valleys Regional Park- The Solution



#### We will be bringing:

- 6-8 Food, 2 Dessert, 1 Alcohol vendors to begin and monitor growth based on guest's attendance and needs
- Garbage cans, park cleaning staff
- Waste Management 15 yrd dumpster dropped off Thurs AM and picked up Friday AM.
- Spoke with Washoe County Health Department, they are very aware of Food Truck Friday operations and have no need for additional permitting or any requirements for 2025.
  - We satisfy their requirements with Waste Management for all waste and you already have a permanent bathroom on site.

#### **NVRP Satisfies our checkboxes for a great family event**

- a good park footprint, surrounded by neighborhoods
- plenty of parking,
- plenty of grass for friends and families to sit together in large groups and enjoy the evening,
- great ingress and egress for our guests,
- minimal impact to residences nearby

# Committed to our business community

- Reno Street Food is committed to local musicians. We only hire local musicians weekly to provide music to our audience sitting in the park.
- In 13 years Food Truck Friday has been instrumental in growing our food truck industry and culture.
- Reno Street Food assisted over 150 new businesses to start, grow and thrive from just an idea.
- Food Truck Friday helps keep over 100 local food vendor businesses in business.
- Reno Street Food held 13 events in 2024. Expanding with Wed 9-13 events TBD and Thurs 9-13
  events TBD
- We had on average 45 or more food, dessert and local craft beer and drink vendors per event.
- Average attendance was between 6000-9000 people every Friday for a high end average total of over 80,000.
- Over \$3,000,000 was tracked from gross sales of all vendors in 2024 in just 65 hours of business, positively impacting city, county and state with sales tax revenue, licensing and permits.
- Reno Street Food allowed 100 businesses to hire more employees and employ over 150 employees every Friday night.

- The main event takes place every Friday 4-9 pm from June August at Idlewild Park.
- Expansion this year. Taking Food Tuck Friday to the community. New North Valley and South Reno locations.
- A free to attend event with live music, lots of grass to sit on with friends and family,
- We are a great family event for locals.
- Relax in the park, bring your lawn chairs and a blanket and let the food trucks cook for you!
- Reno Street Food is THE original weekly gourmet street food event in Reno put on by locals for locals.
