



May Arboretum Report Feb 2026 – Mar 2026

Highlights

- ◆ 12,794 individuals visited the May Arboretum
- ◆ Greenhouse planting of 2026 seedlings began. So far 4,000 seeds have been planted and 2,500 plugs received.
- ◆ 11 inches of snow fell in Arboretum with no damage to trees.
- ◆ Memorial installed at Bree Megan's Garden

Arboretum Operations

- ◆ 6 trees had dead removed from the canopy.
- ◆ 1 Giant Sequoia removed due to its high risk of damaging Washoe County structure. Wood was milled and donated.
- ◆ 2nd Arborist apprentice began their program with the May Arboretum.
- ◆ We have received about 30 yards of organic mulch from local tree companies to add to the garden beds.
- ◆ Parts of the old Great Basin Adventure have been cleaned up.
- ◆ Water was turned on March 12 which is about a month earlier than last year
