How we Measure your Home to Determine Occupancy:

How we Measure:

Washoe County Building Inspectors measure your home with a laser. They will round-up to the nearest full inch.

Example: If your space is 14 feet and 1 ¼ inches, our inspectors will notate 14 feet, 2 inches.

What is Habitable Space?

Only habitable space counts towards your square footage.

Habitable Space: Kitchen, Bedrooms, Living Room, Office, Den NON-Habitable Space: Closets, Hallways, Garages, Utility Rooms

How is Habitable Space calculated?

The square footage of your habitable space is divided by 200 to calculate your **allowable occupancy**.

The habitable square footage determines your <u>maximum legal occupancy</u>, which will be posted on your permit card and cannot be changed until the Ordinance is changed.

The County plans to propose a less stringent calculation when we go before the Board of County Commissioners in November. If the Ordinance is changed, we will retroactively update your permit occupancy.
