_____ I understand I have been charged with driving or being in actual physical control of a motor vehicle on a highway or on premises to which the public has access in this county (initial applicable element)

_____ while under the influence of intoxicating liqueur; and/ or
_____ having 0.08% or more concentration of alcohol in my blood; and/or
_____ having been under the influence of a controlled substance.

_____ I understand that if my blood alcohol content is 0.16% or higher I must obtain a substance use disorder evaluation.

_____ I understand the State must prove the elements in the above paragraph beyond a reasonable doubt, and I give up this right.

_____ I understand the State will use this and any other constitutionally valid prior conviction of this type of offense to enhance the penalty or any subsequent offense.

_____ I understand the following penalties for a DUI in Nevada are:

_____ **1st Offense** in 7 years: A minimum of 2 days in jail to a maximum of 6 months jail, or a minimum of 2 days to a maximum of 6 months of residential confinement or not less than 48 hours but not more than 96 hours of community service; a fine of not less than \$400.00 nor more than \$1,000.00 and assessments; successful completion of an approved educational or treatment course on the abuse of alcohol and / or controlled substances; attendance at a live Victim Impact Panel; and, revocation of my Nevada Driver's License by the Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles for 185 days unless I am approved for an ignition interlock device or Nevada 24/7 Sobriety Program.

_____ **2nd Offense** in 7 years: A minimum of 20 days to a maximum of 6 months in jail, or a minimum of 20 days to a maximum of 6 months of residential confinement; a minimum fine of \$750.00 to a maximum of \$1,000.00 and assessments or the equivalent number of hours of community service; obtain an evaluation; completion of a program of treatment for the abuse of alcohol and / or controlled substances; attendance at a live Victim Impact Panel; 5-day vehicle registration
